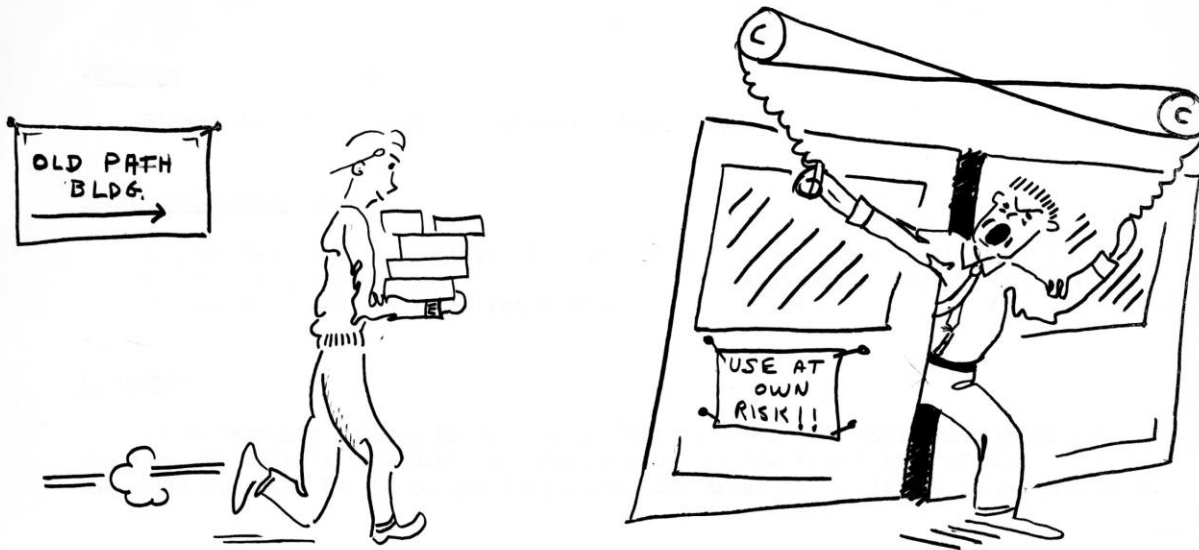

A Happy, Healthy, Successful New Year.

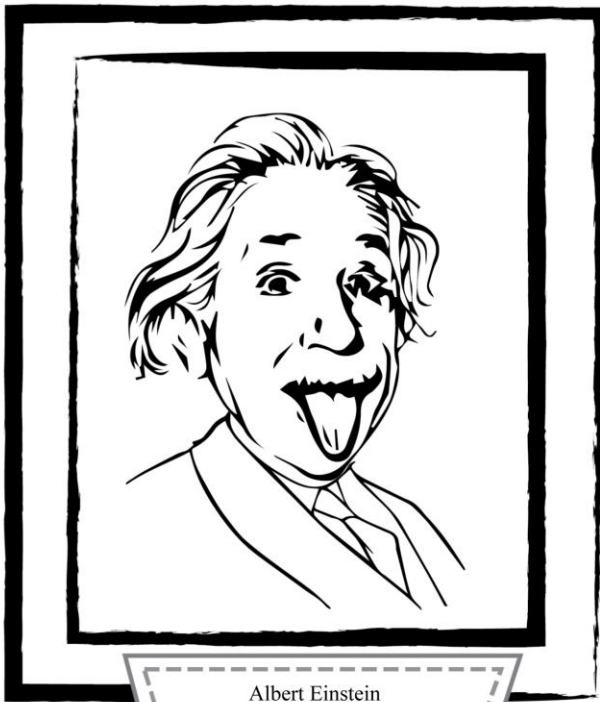

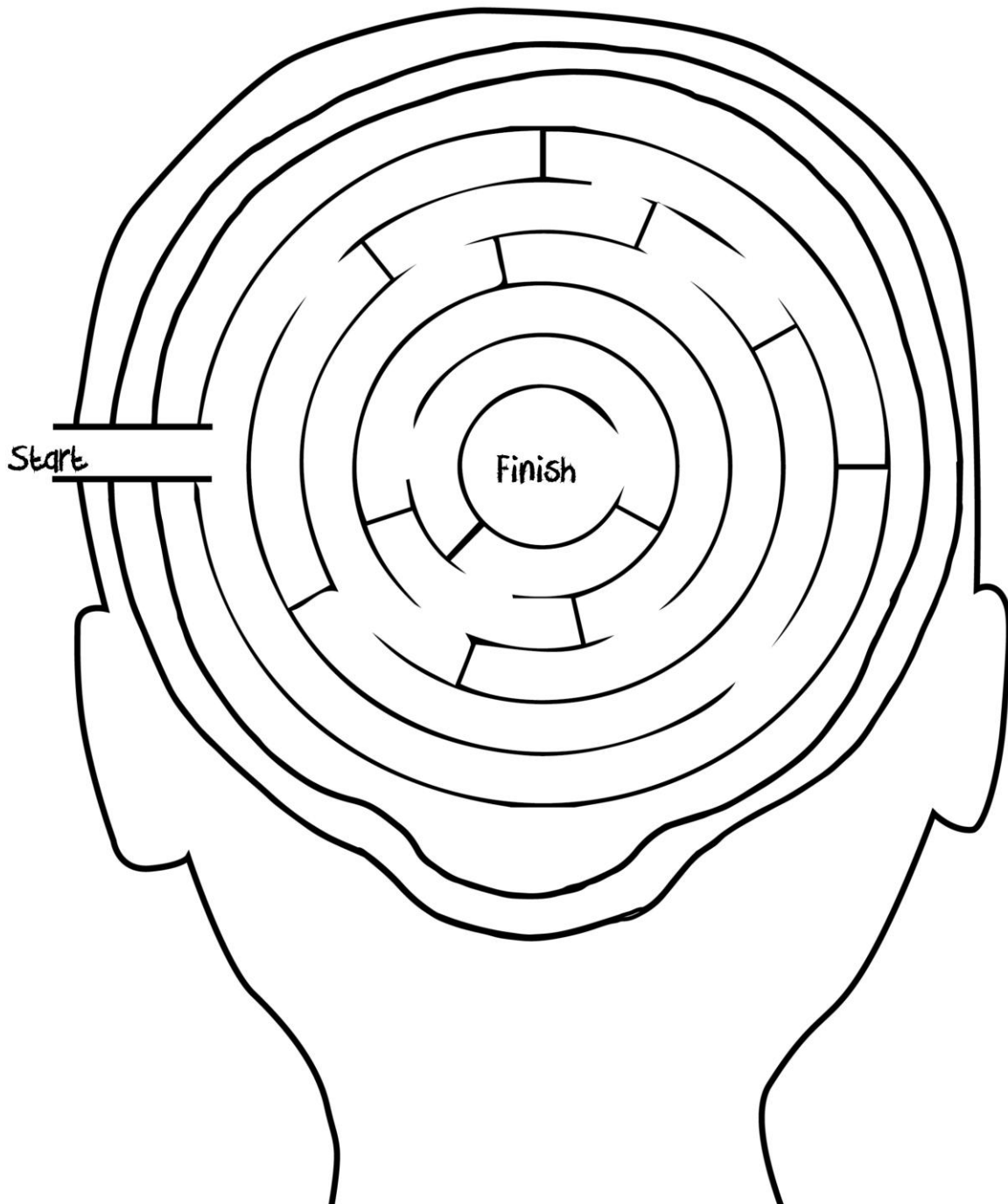

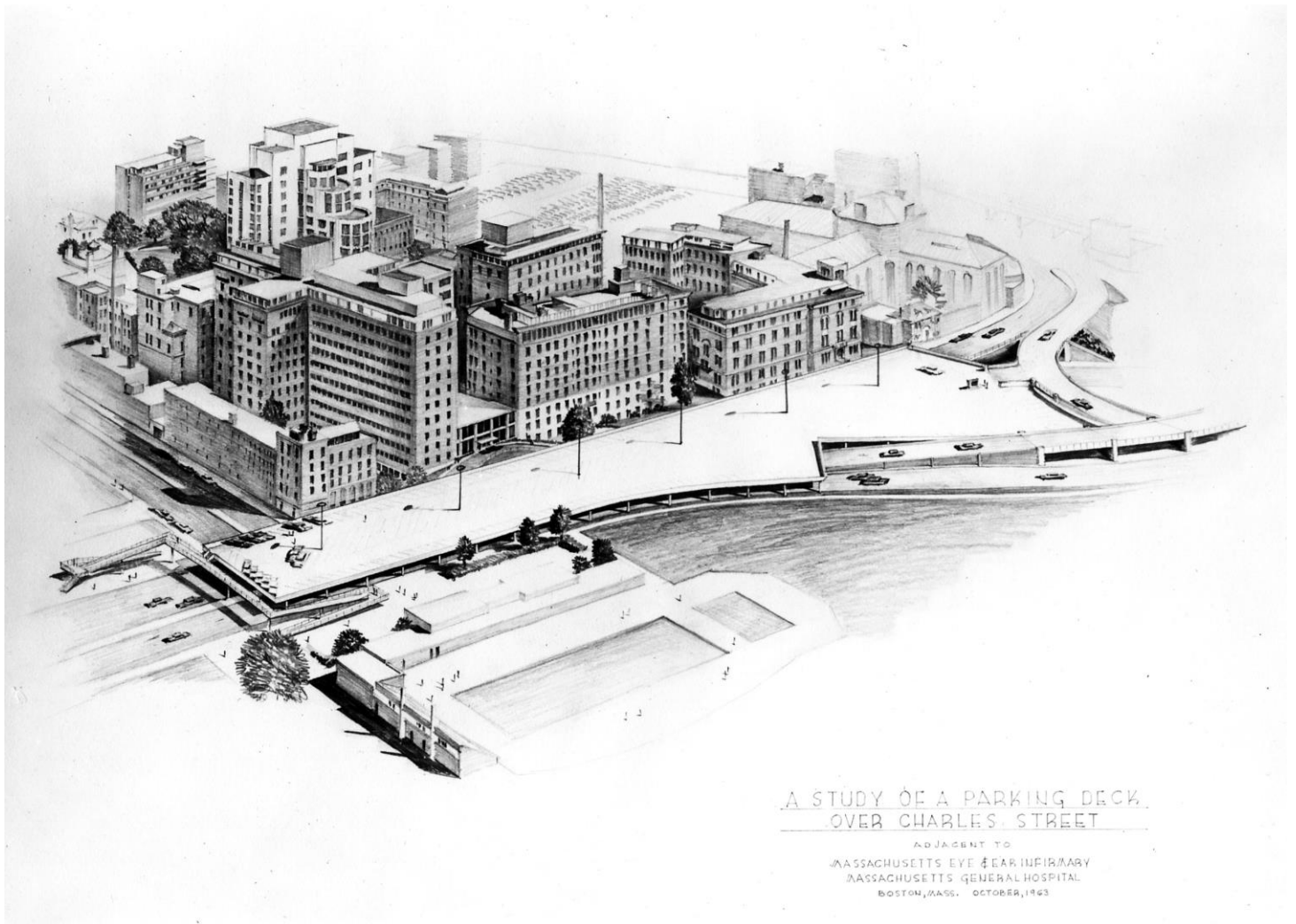

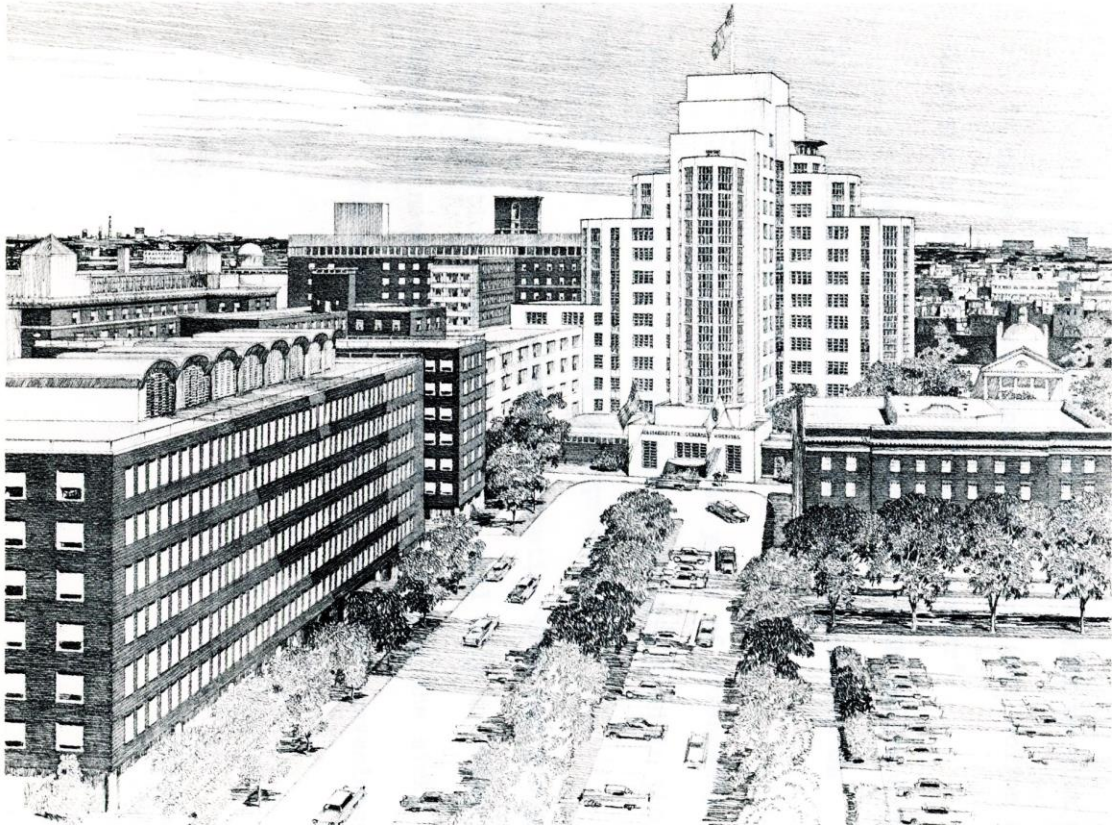

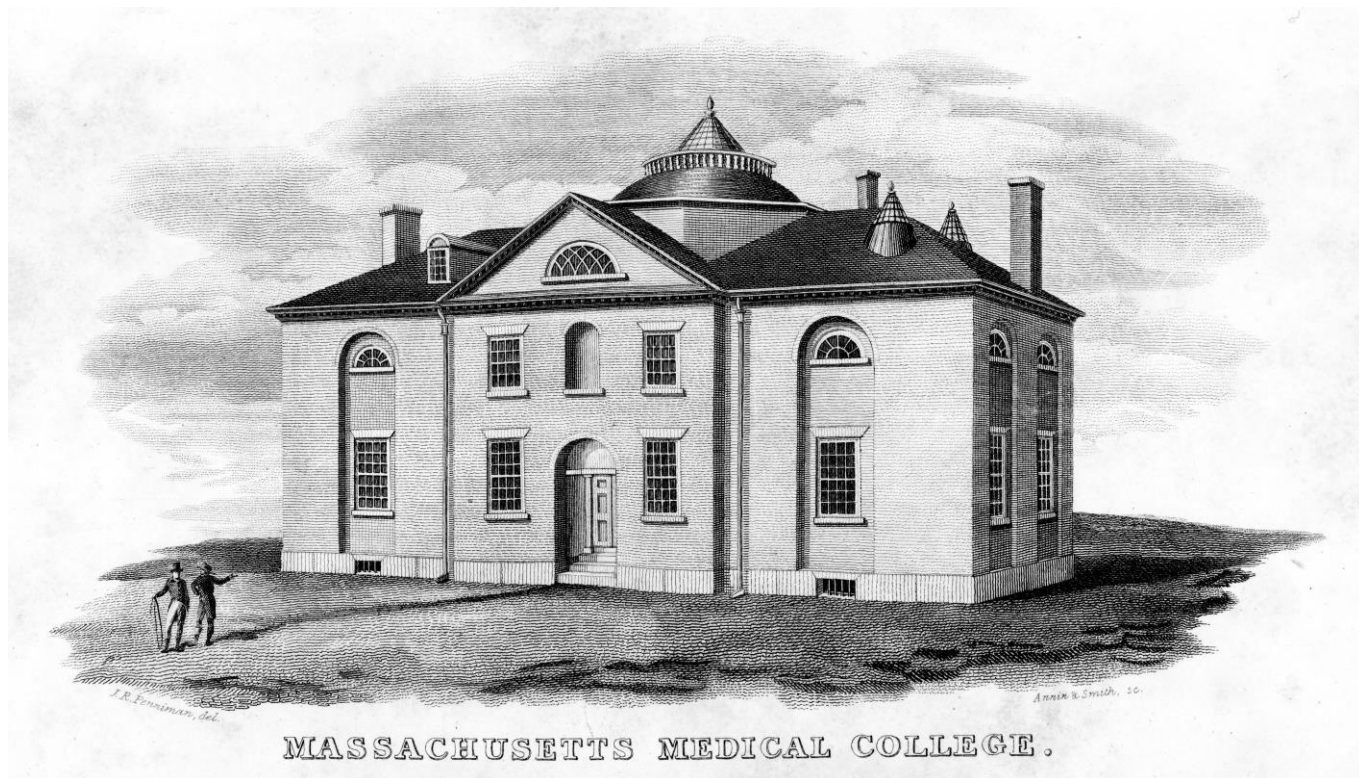


A STUDY OF A PARKING DECK
OVER CHARLES STREET

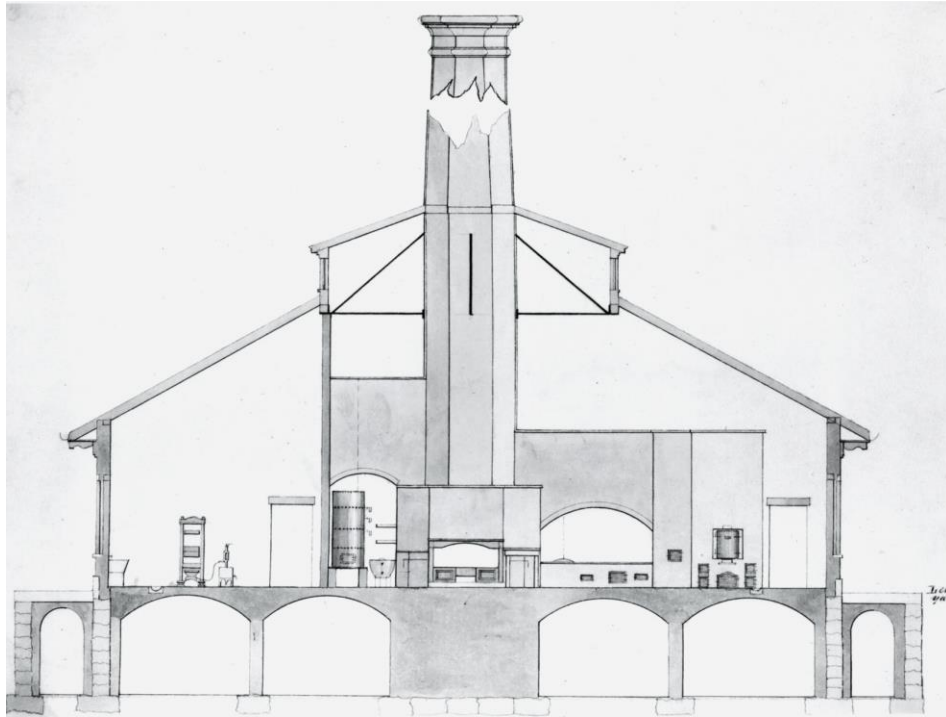
