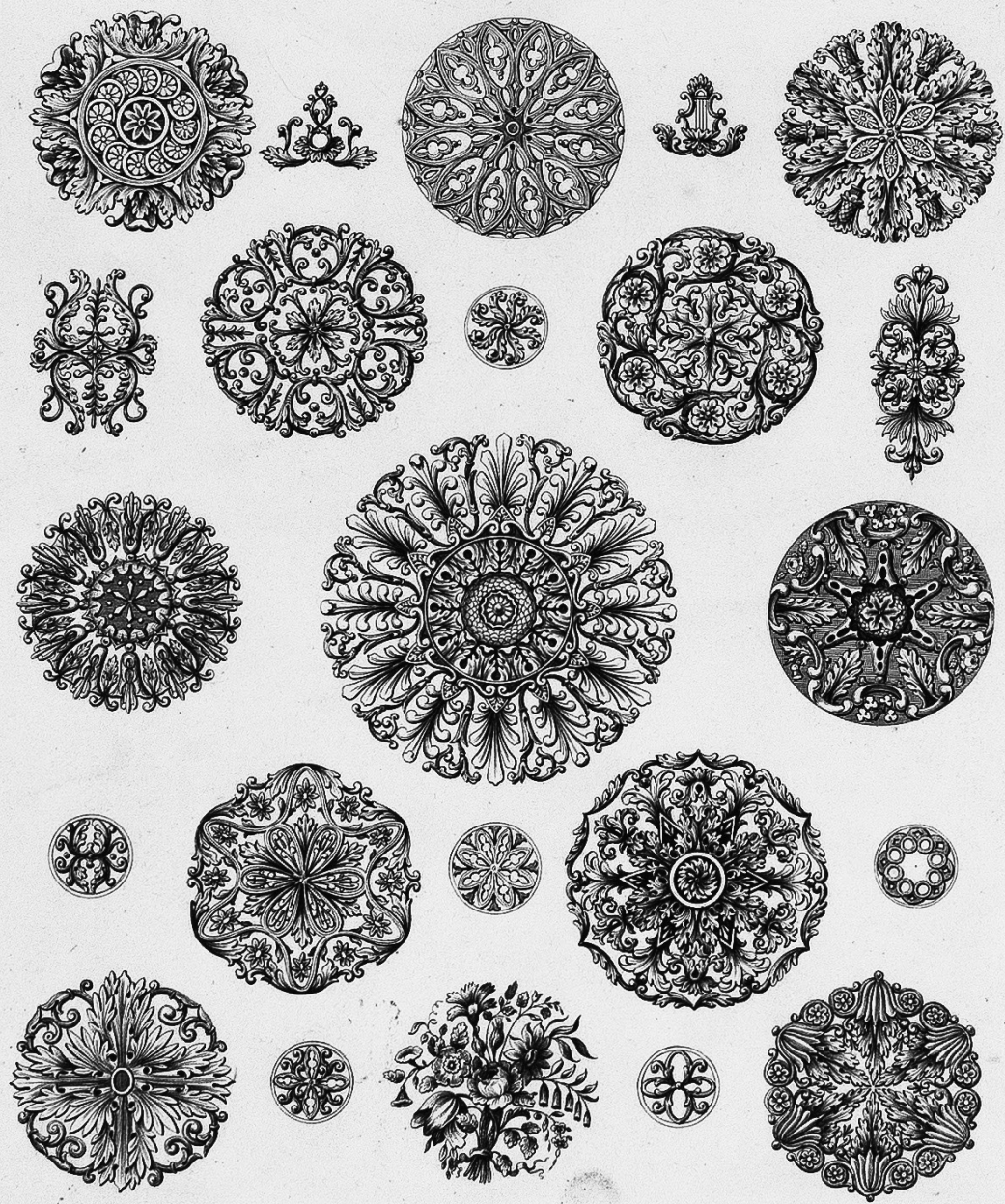

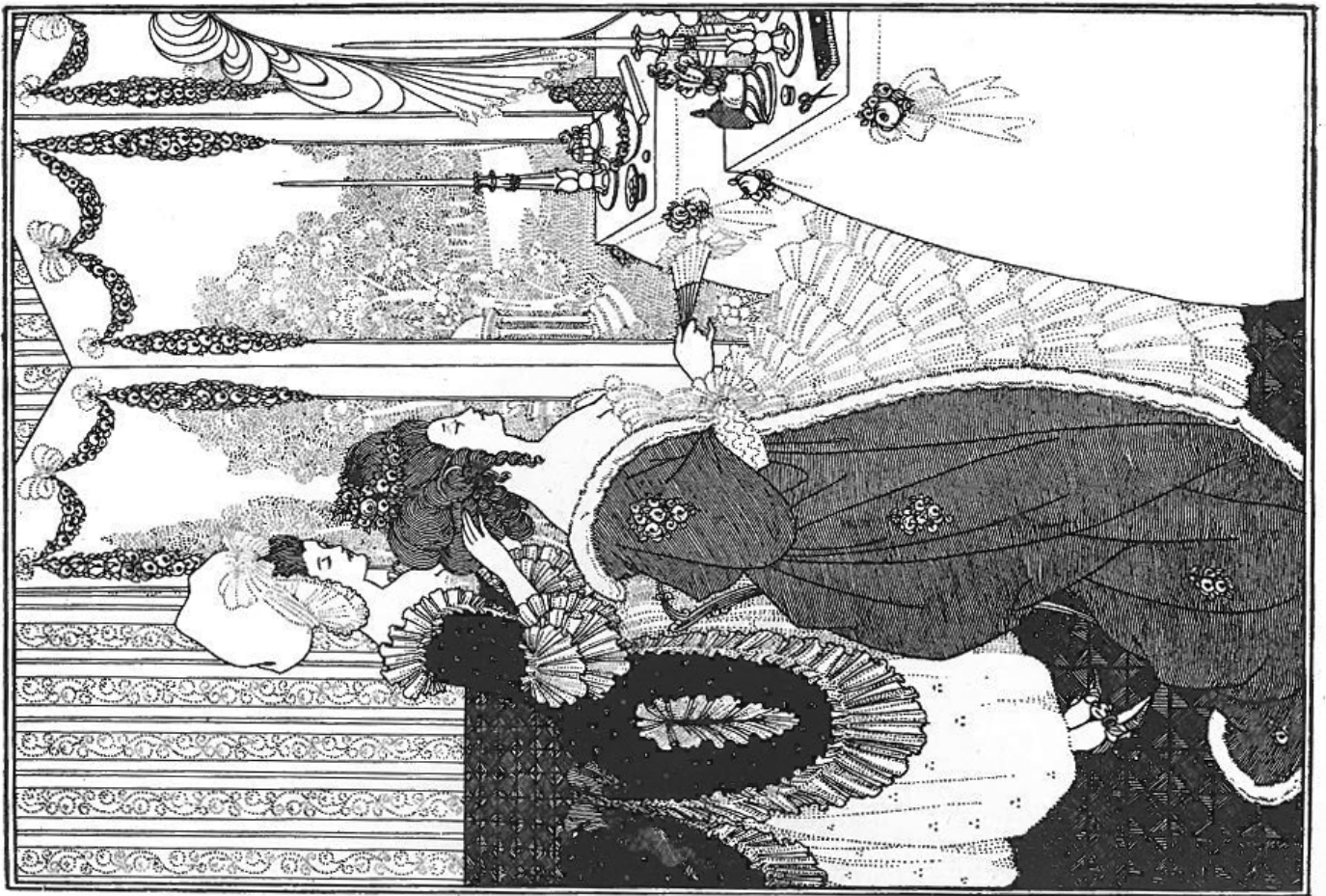
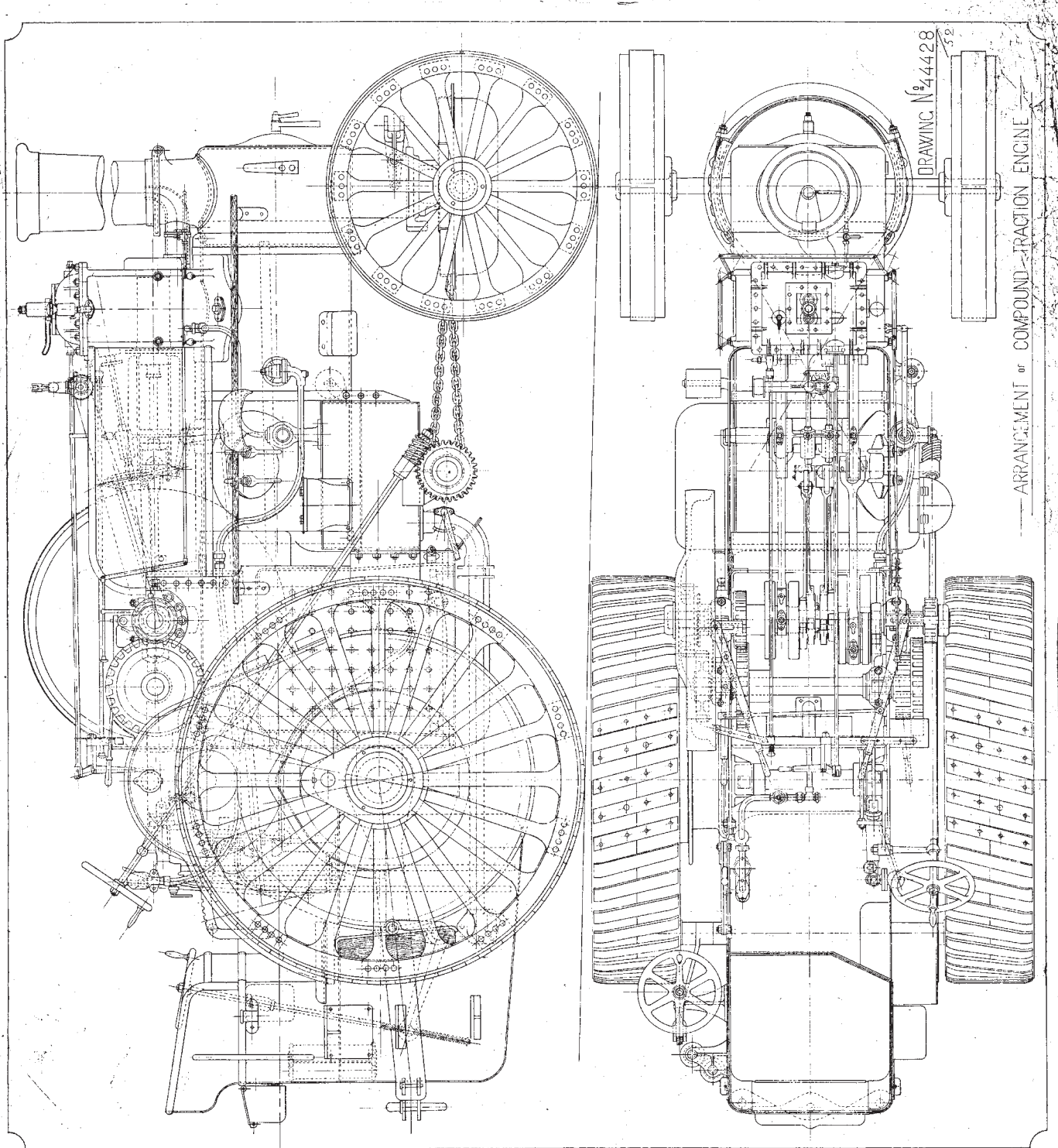


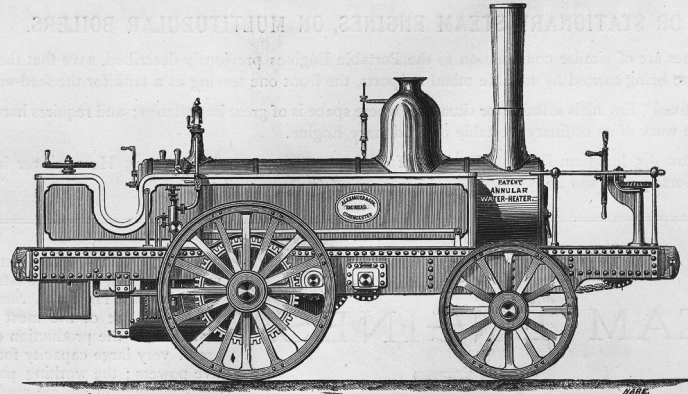

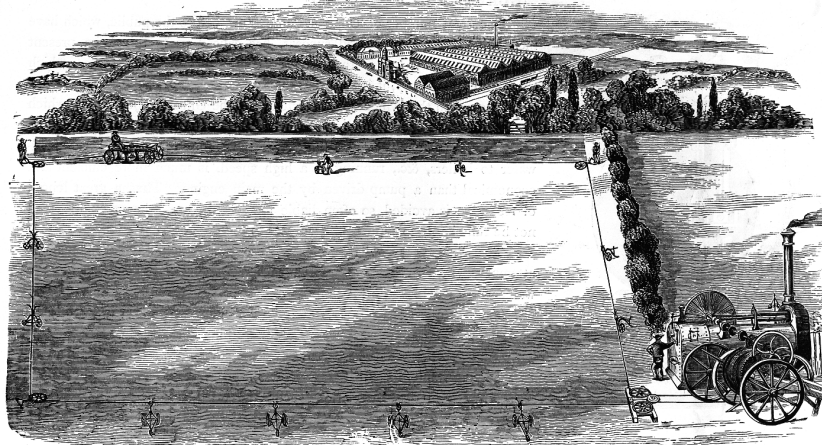
IMPROVED ROAD LOCOMOTIVE ENGINE.



SCALE 2" TO THE FOOT

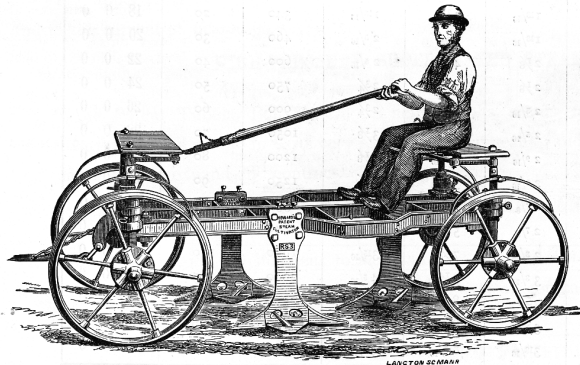

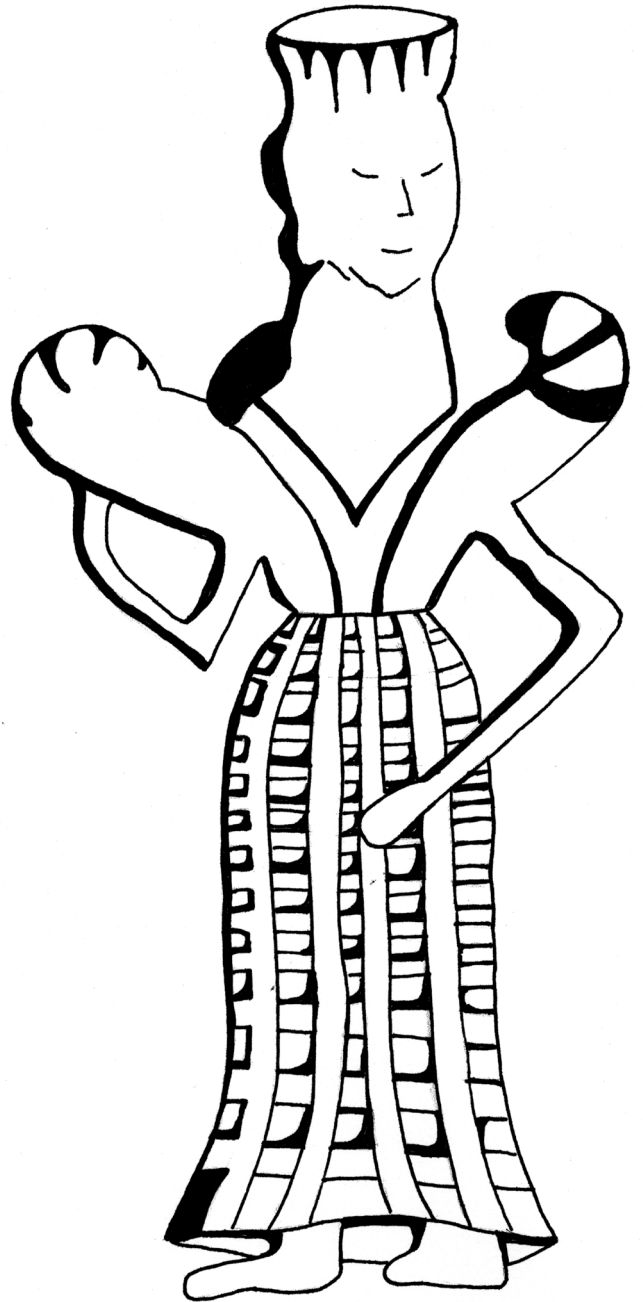
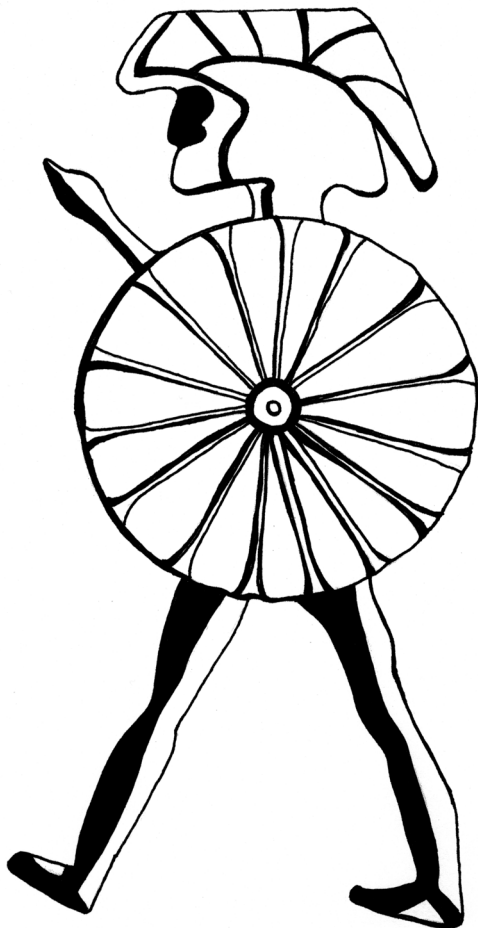
