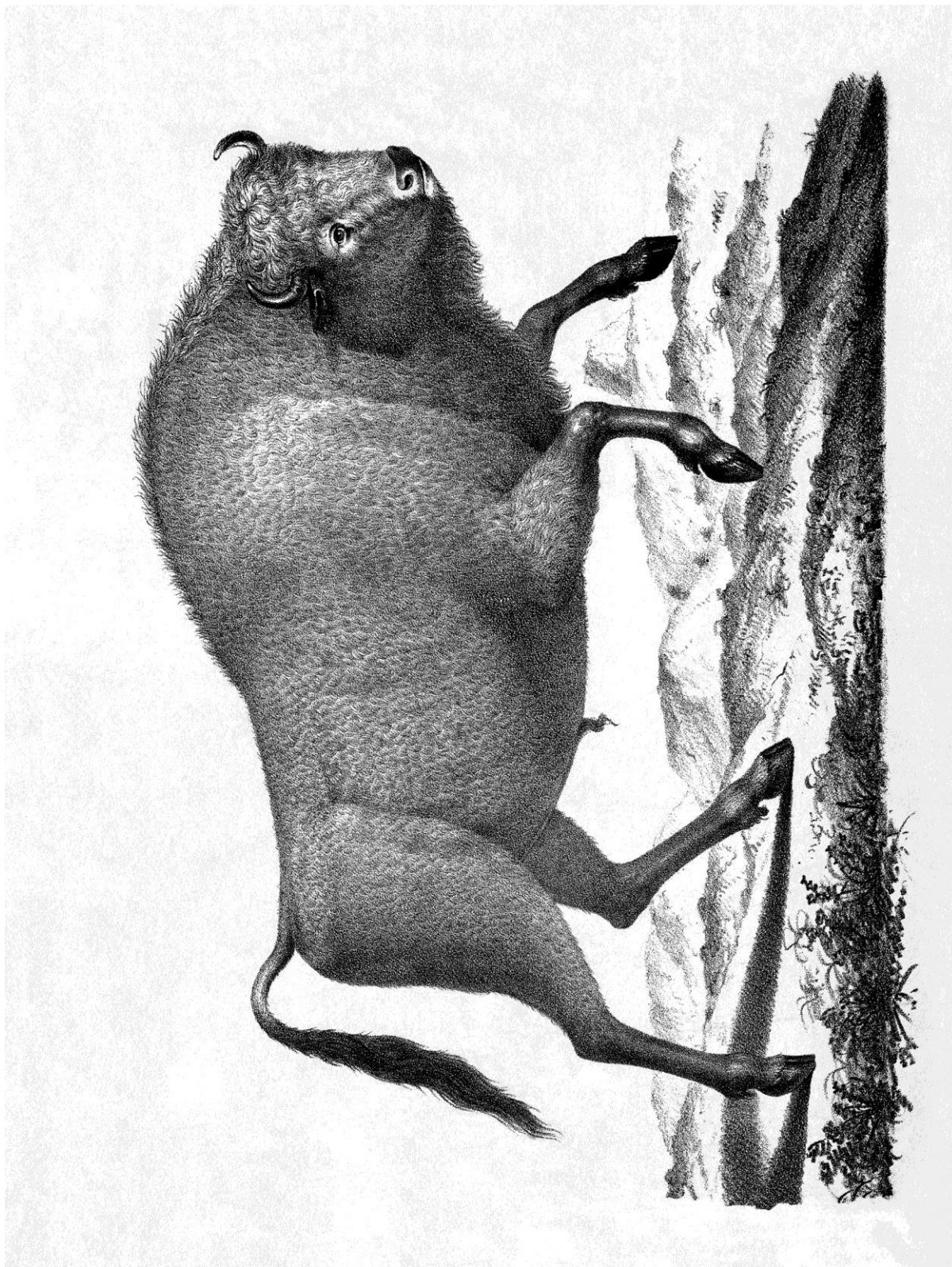

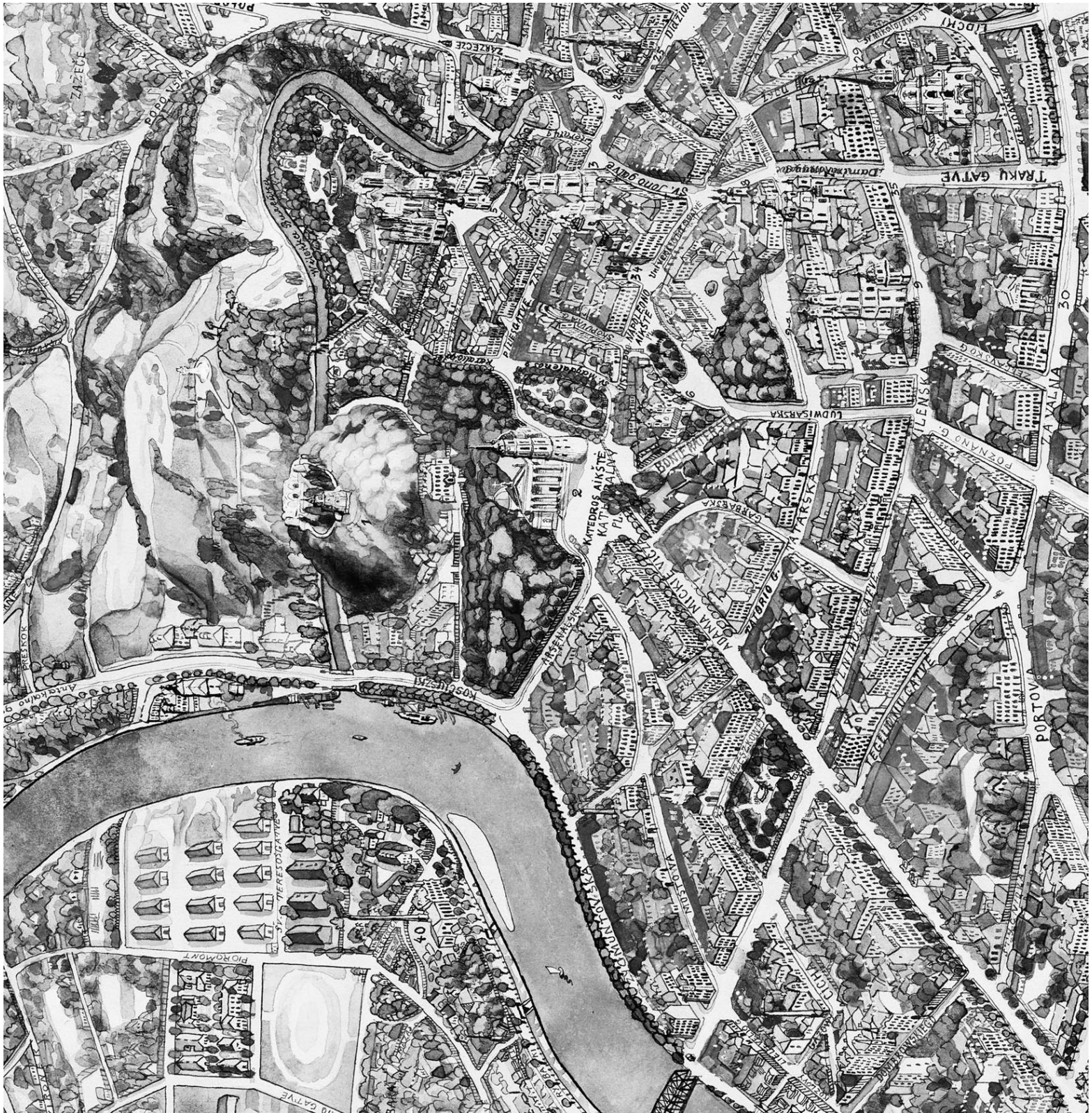

Juozapas Kamarauskas. *Vilnius. Castle.* 1893.

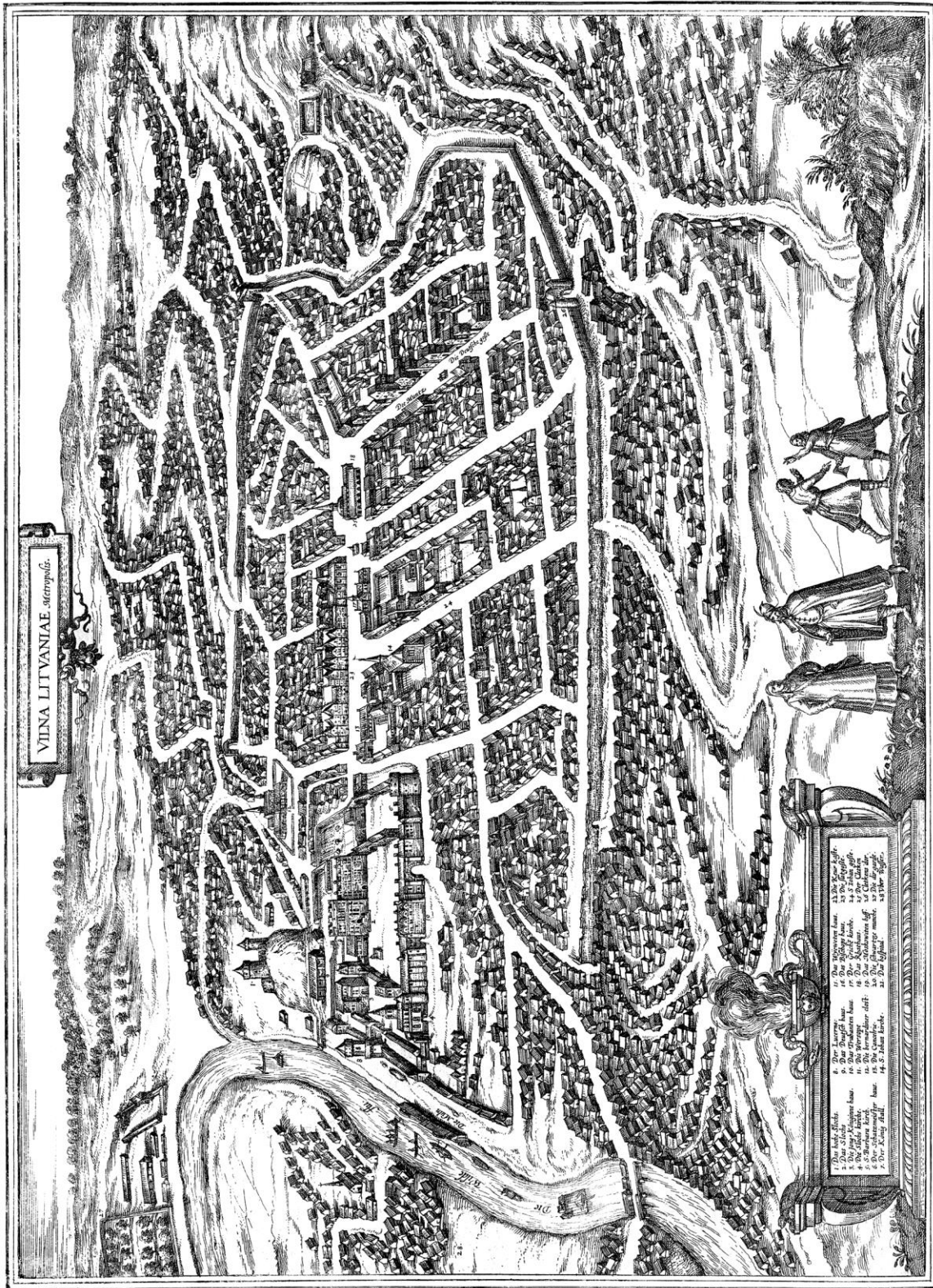

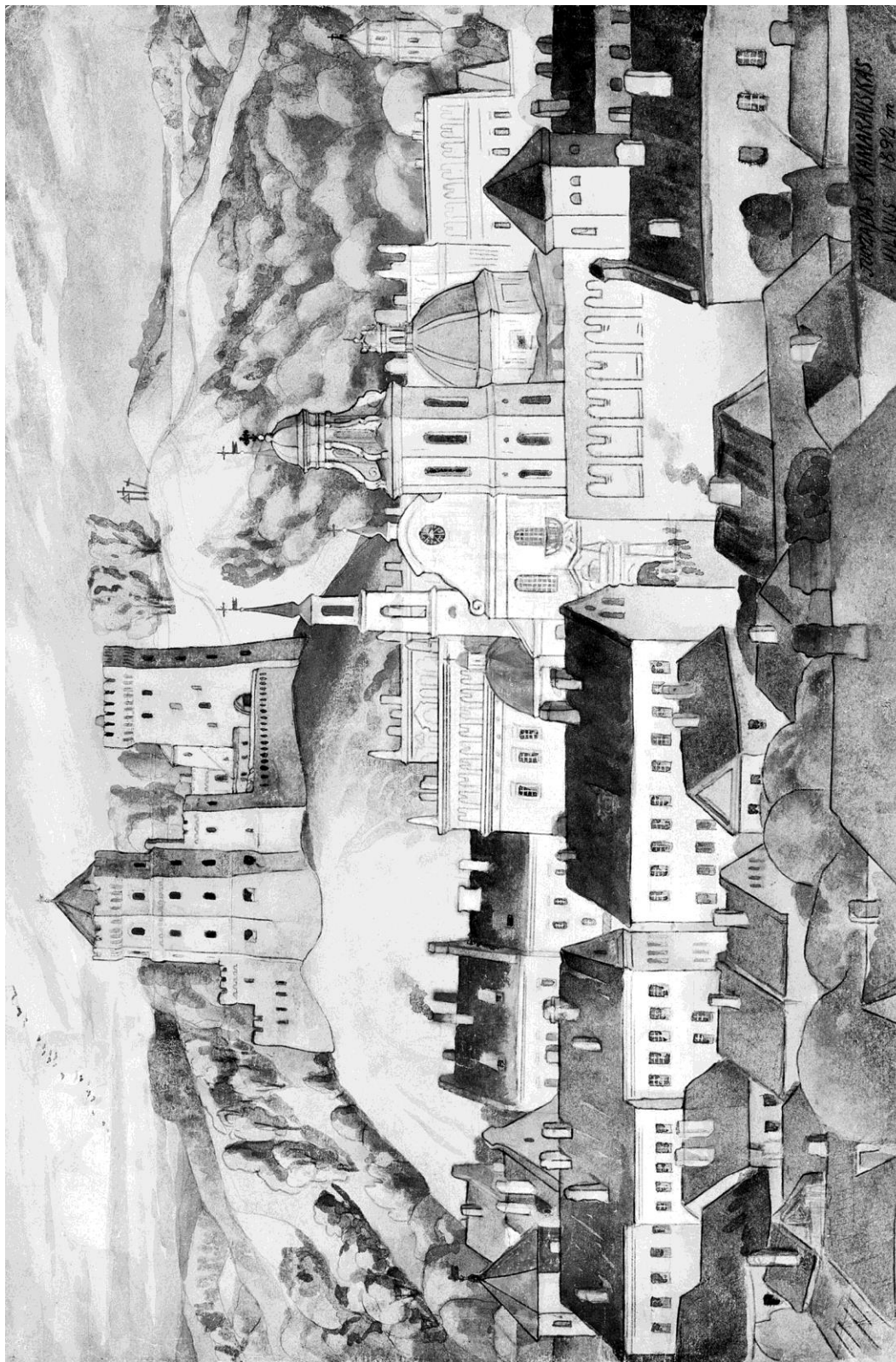
Juozapas Kamarauskas. *Map of Vilnius* (fragment). 1923.

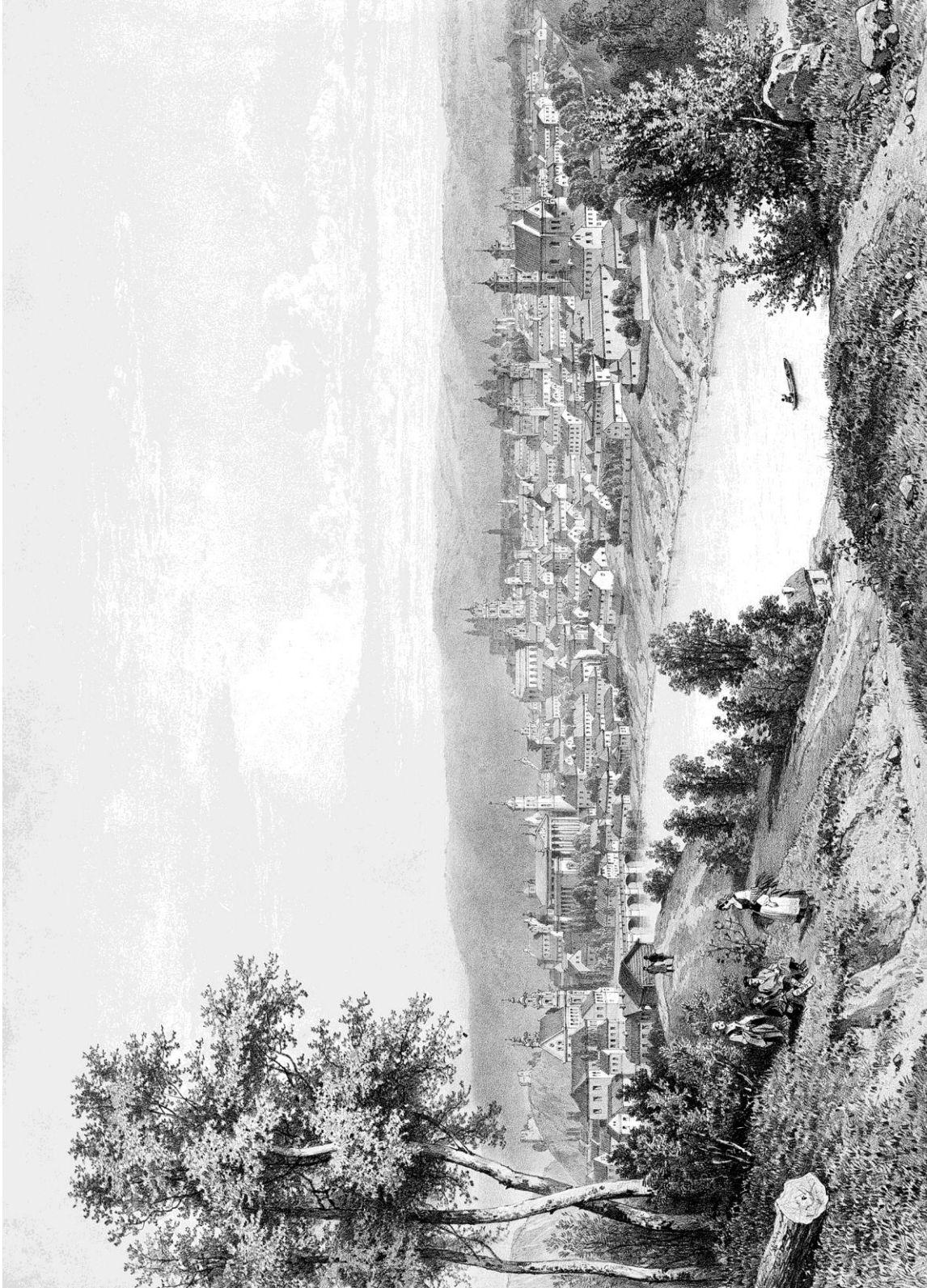
Juozapas Kamarauskas. *Vilnius. Gediminas' Castle*. 1892.
