


FIG. 1.—Glossary chart giving the names of the various sections of a male fowl.

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


FIGURE 36.—Argonne Research Reactor (CP-5) Tank Type with Heavy Water, (1) Access to Vertical Thimbles, (2) Graphite, (3) Fuel Assembles, (4) Thermal Column, (5) Circulating Pump, (6) D₂O—H₂O Heat Exchanger, (7) D₂O Storage, (8) Reactor Tank, (9) Pneumatic Tubes, (10) Beam Hole, (11) Heavy Water (D₂O), (12) Control Arms, and (13) Control Room.
