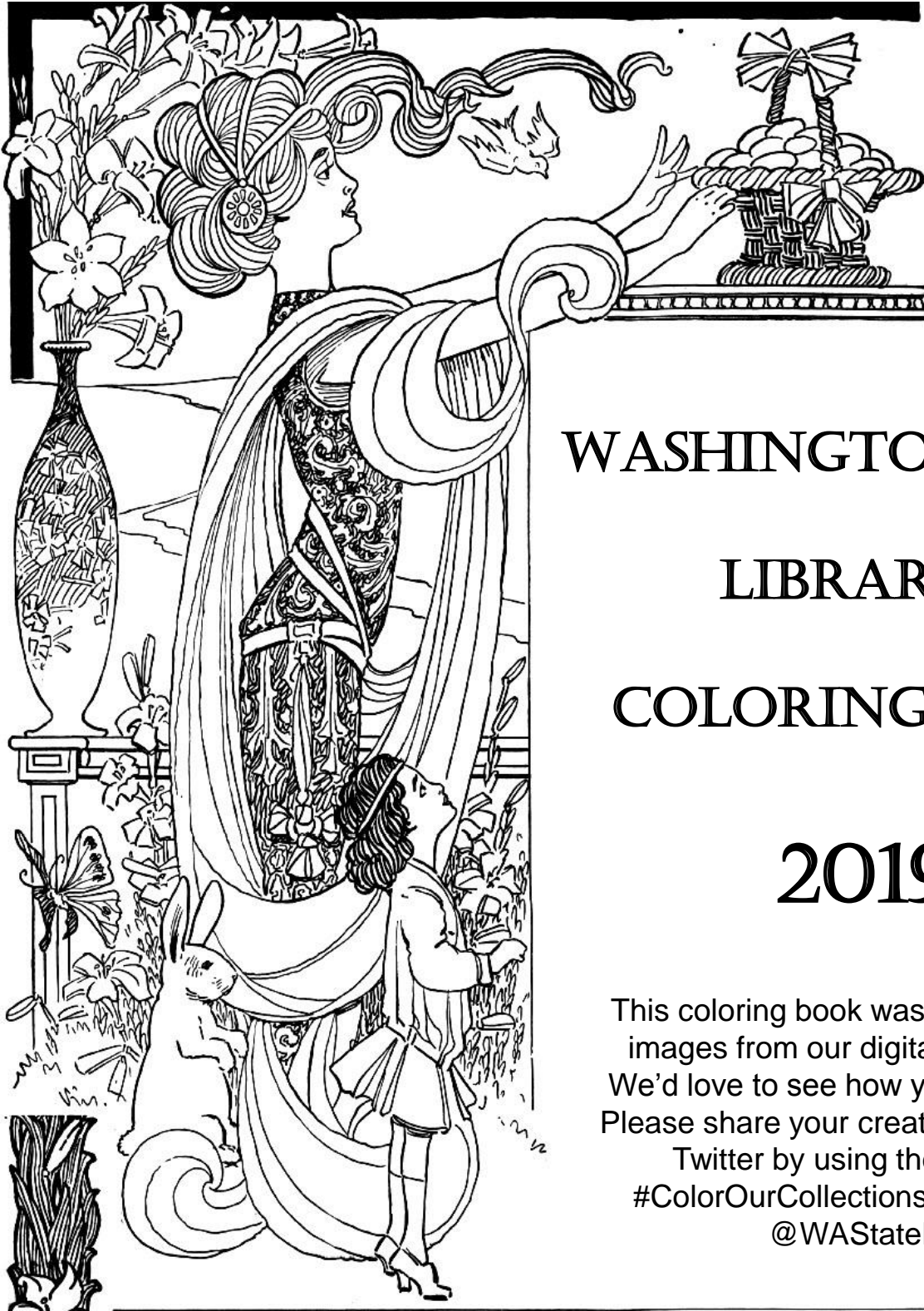

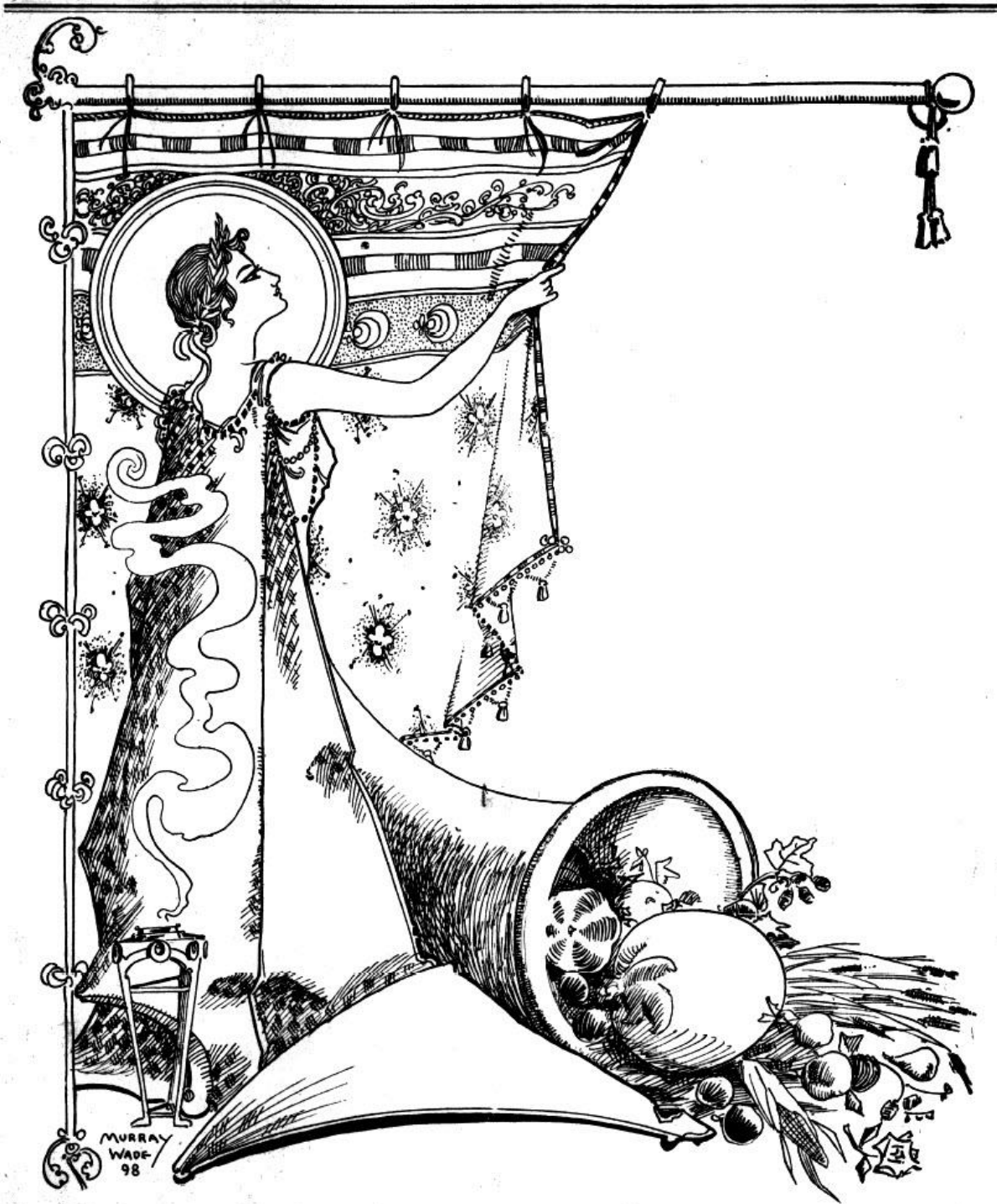


RING-NECKED PHEASANT

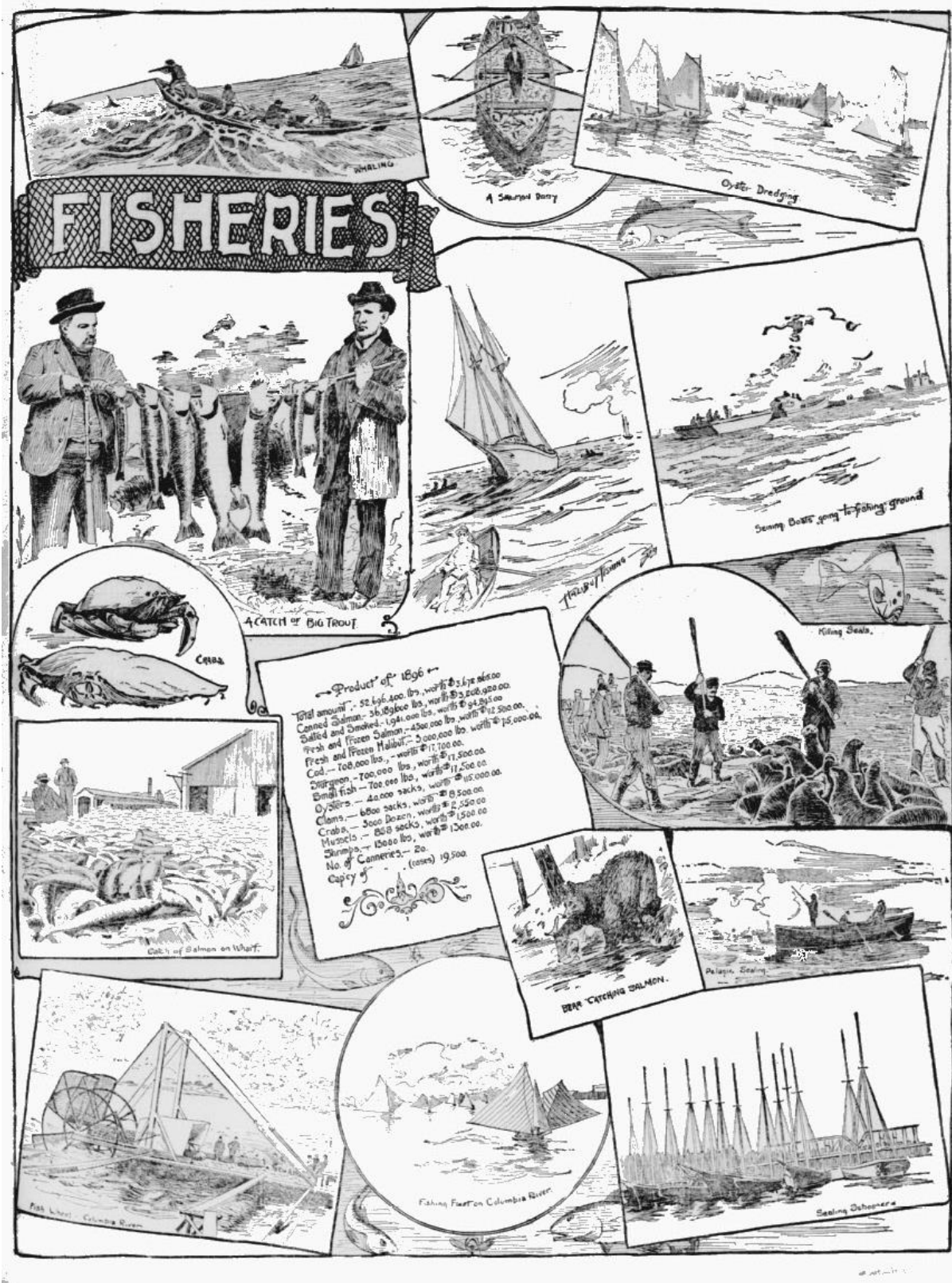
