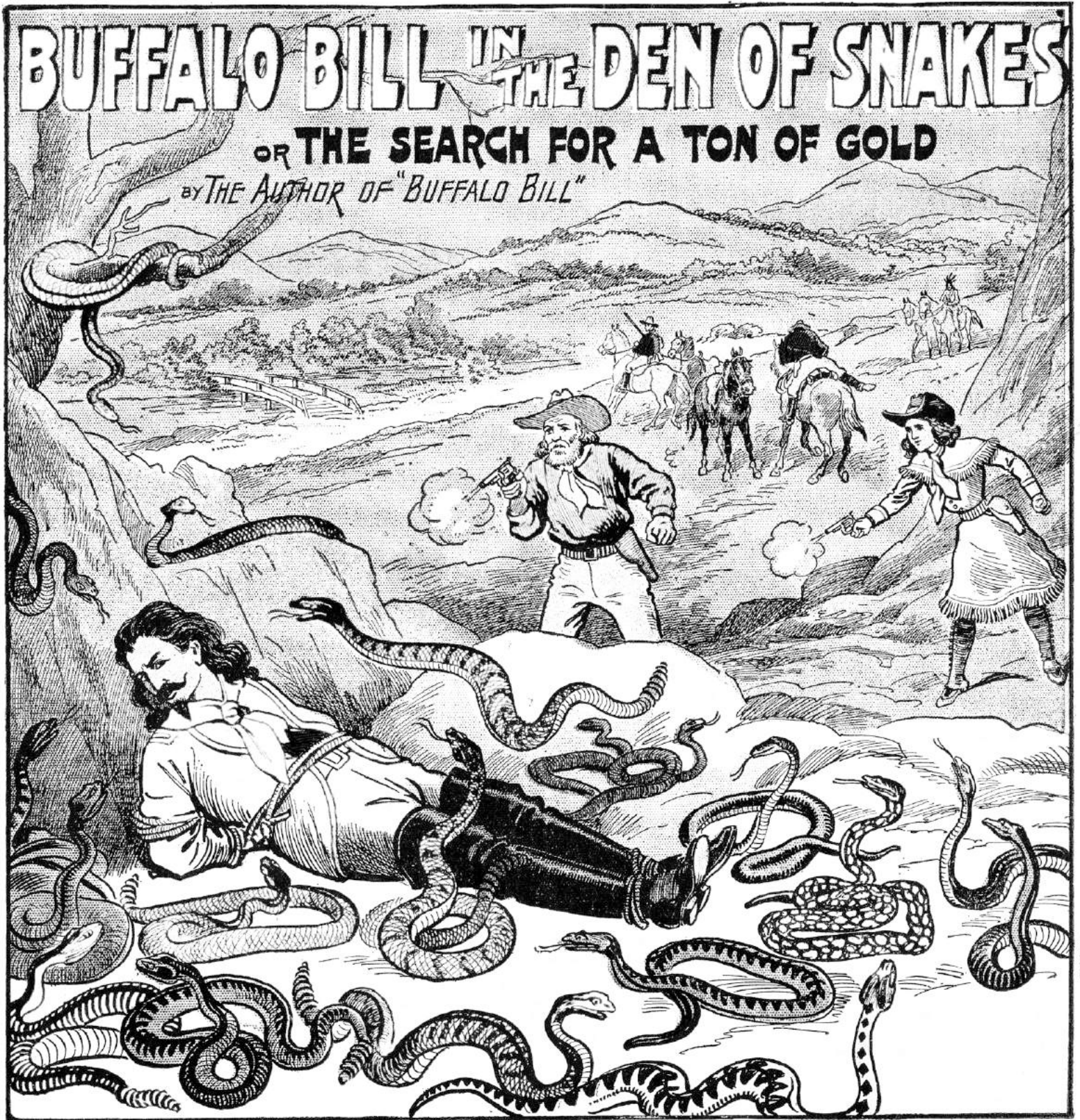

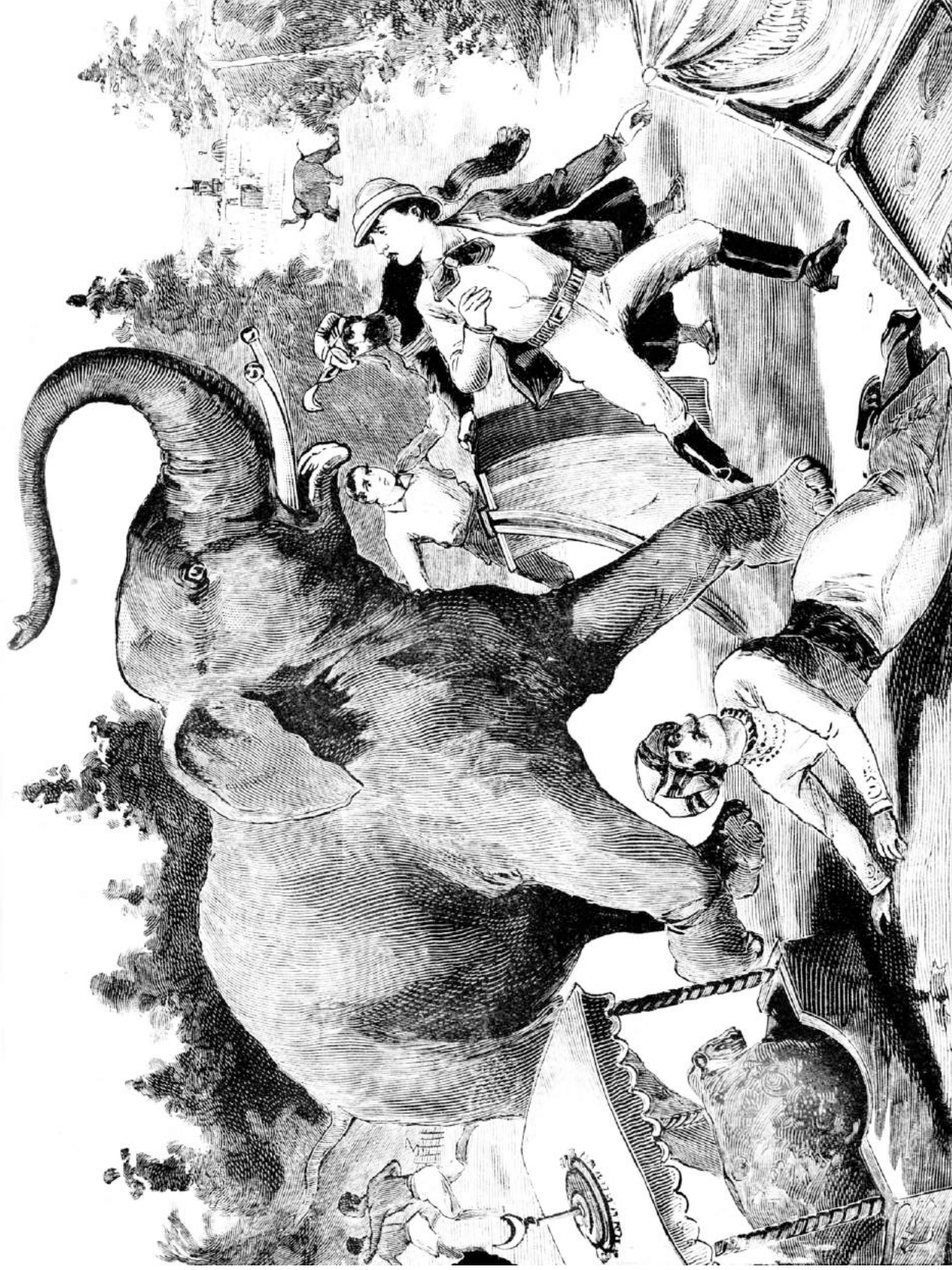


As the snake measured its length in the air, there was a report of two pistols, and the reptile's head dropped to the floor of the cave several feet away. It had been shot through the neck.

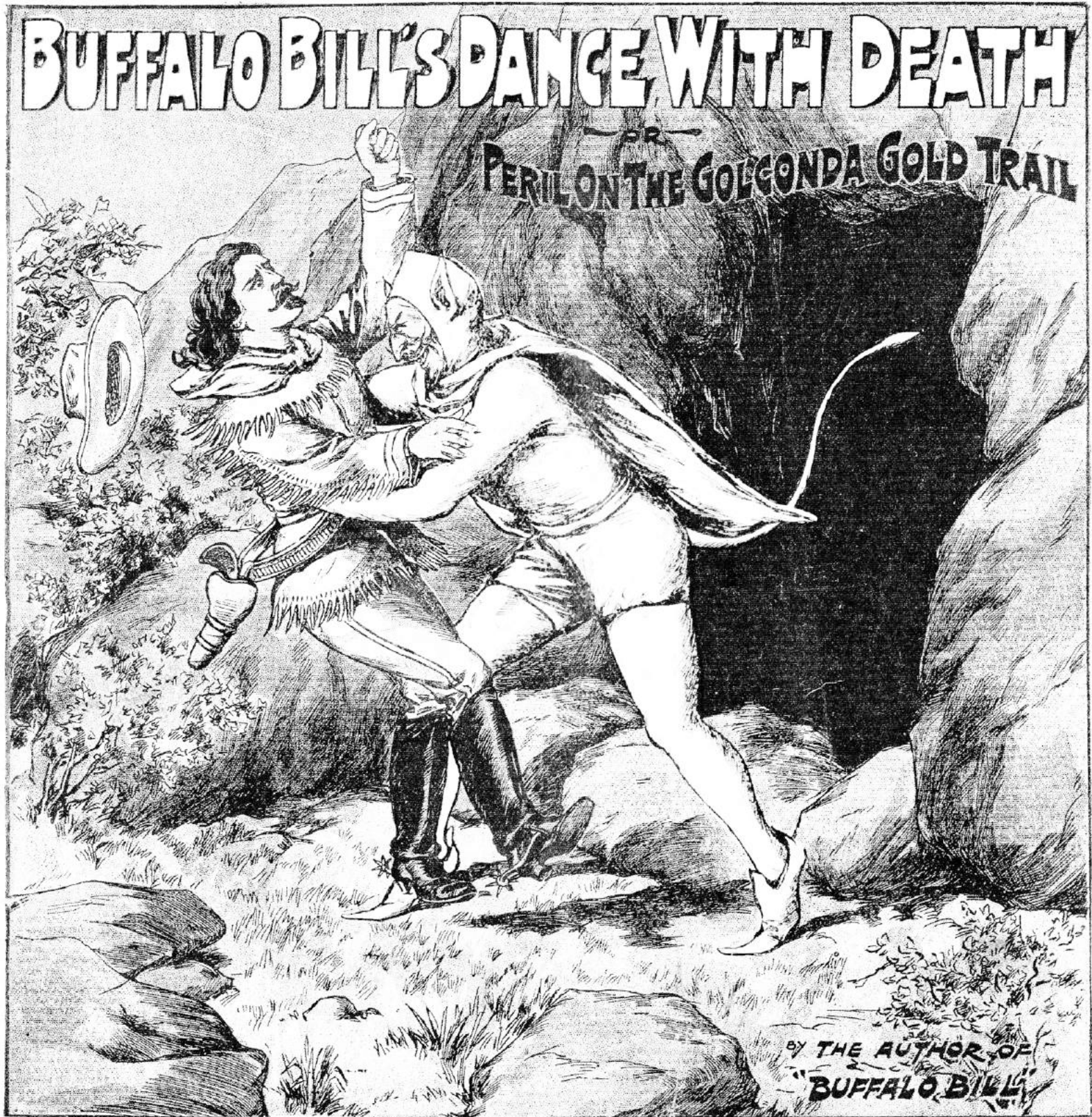
