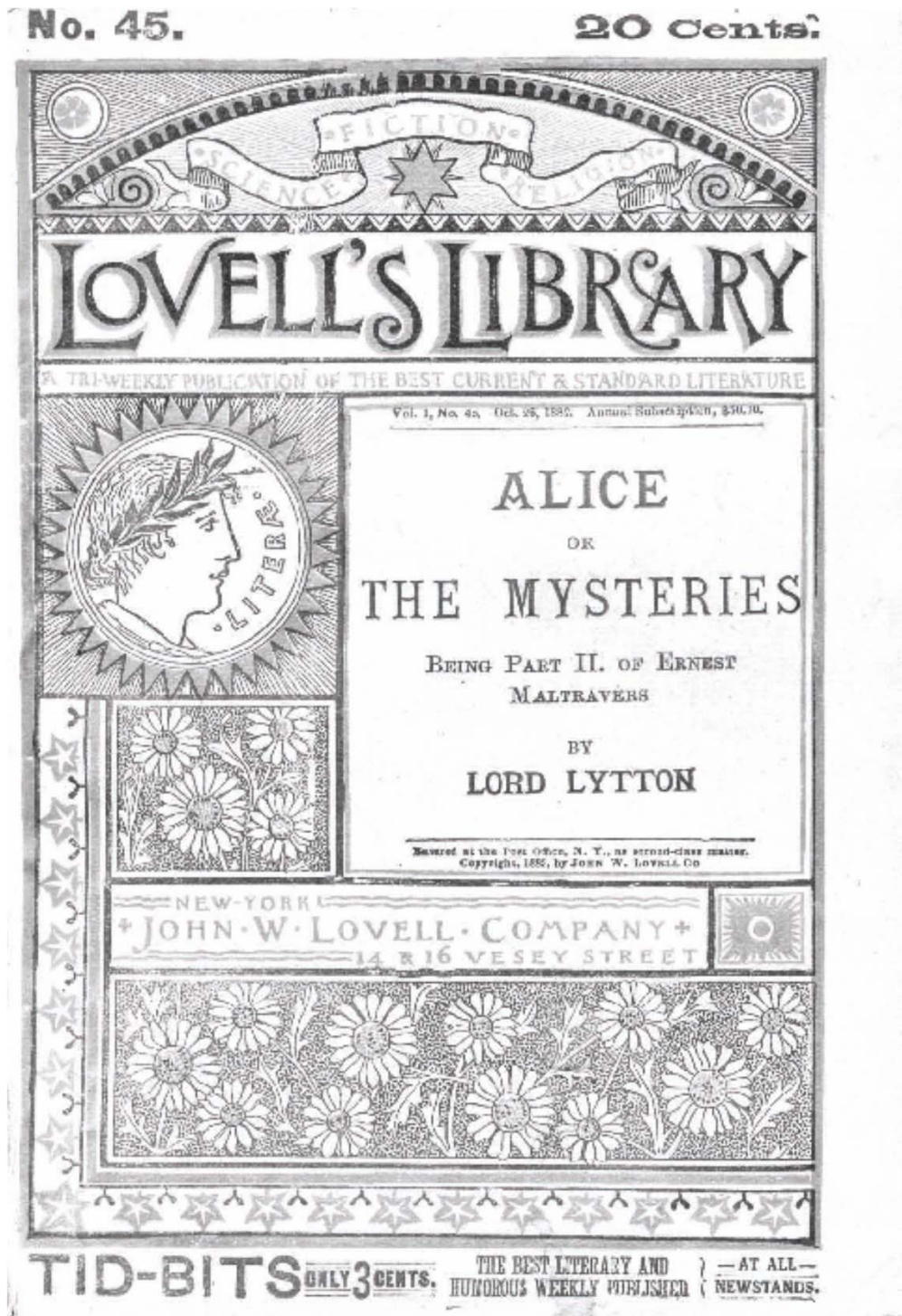

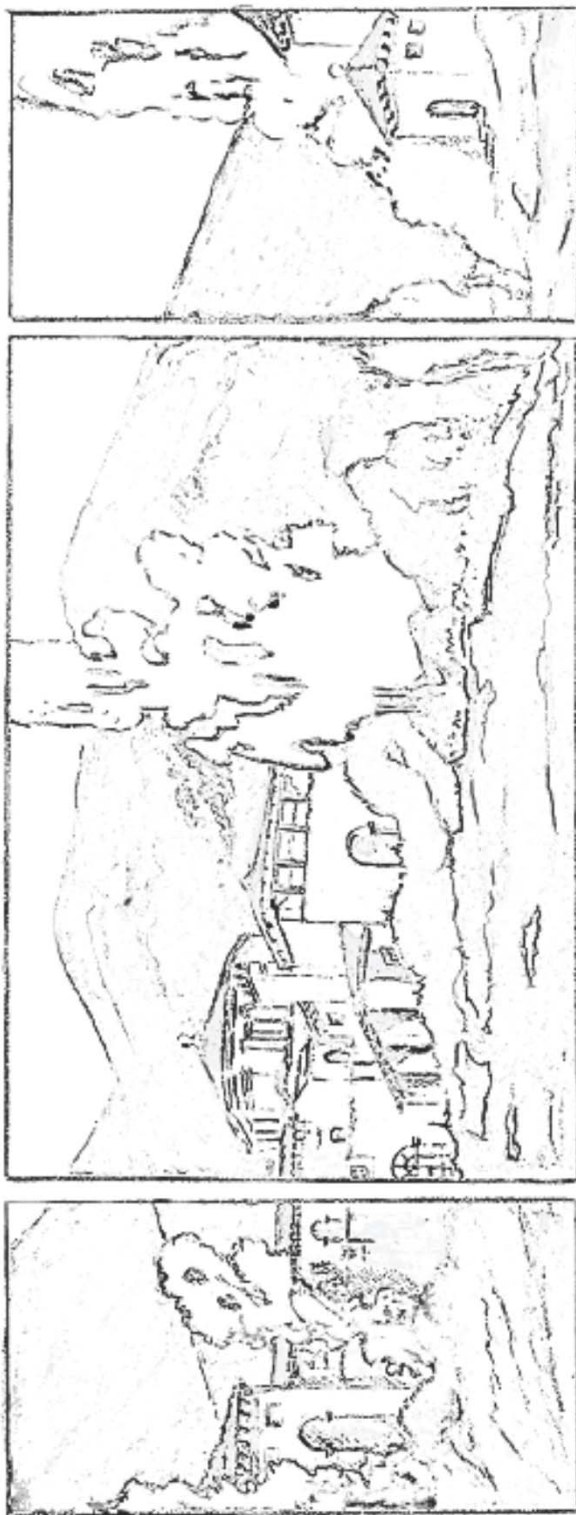

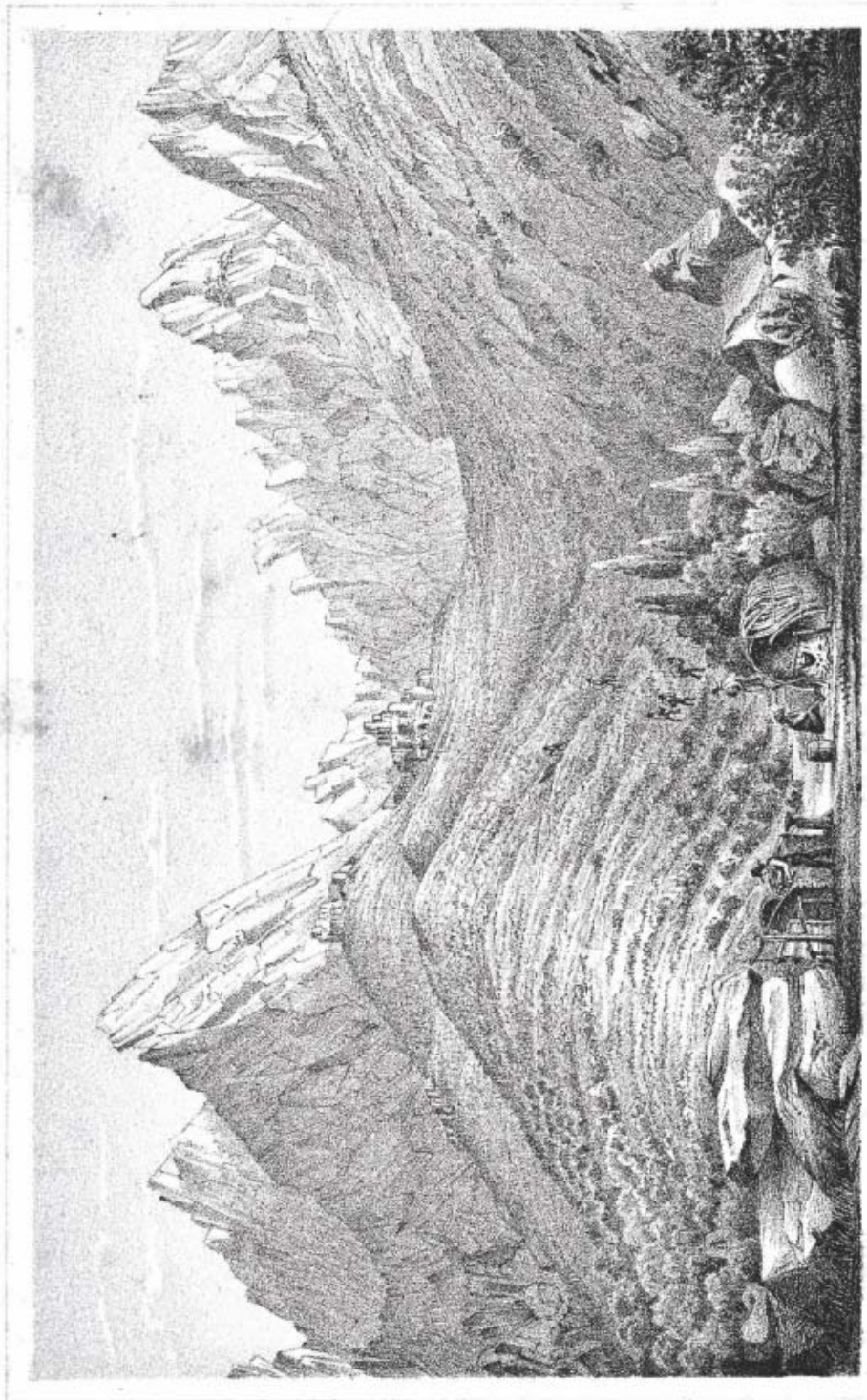

Architectural sketch by New Mexico College of Agriculture and Mechanic Arts student Ernest Arthur Withers, class of 1938. From the NMSU University Archives.

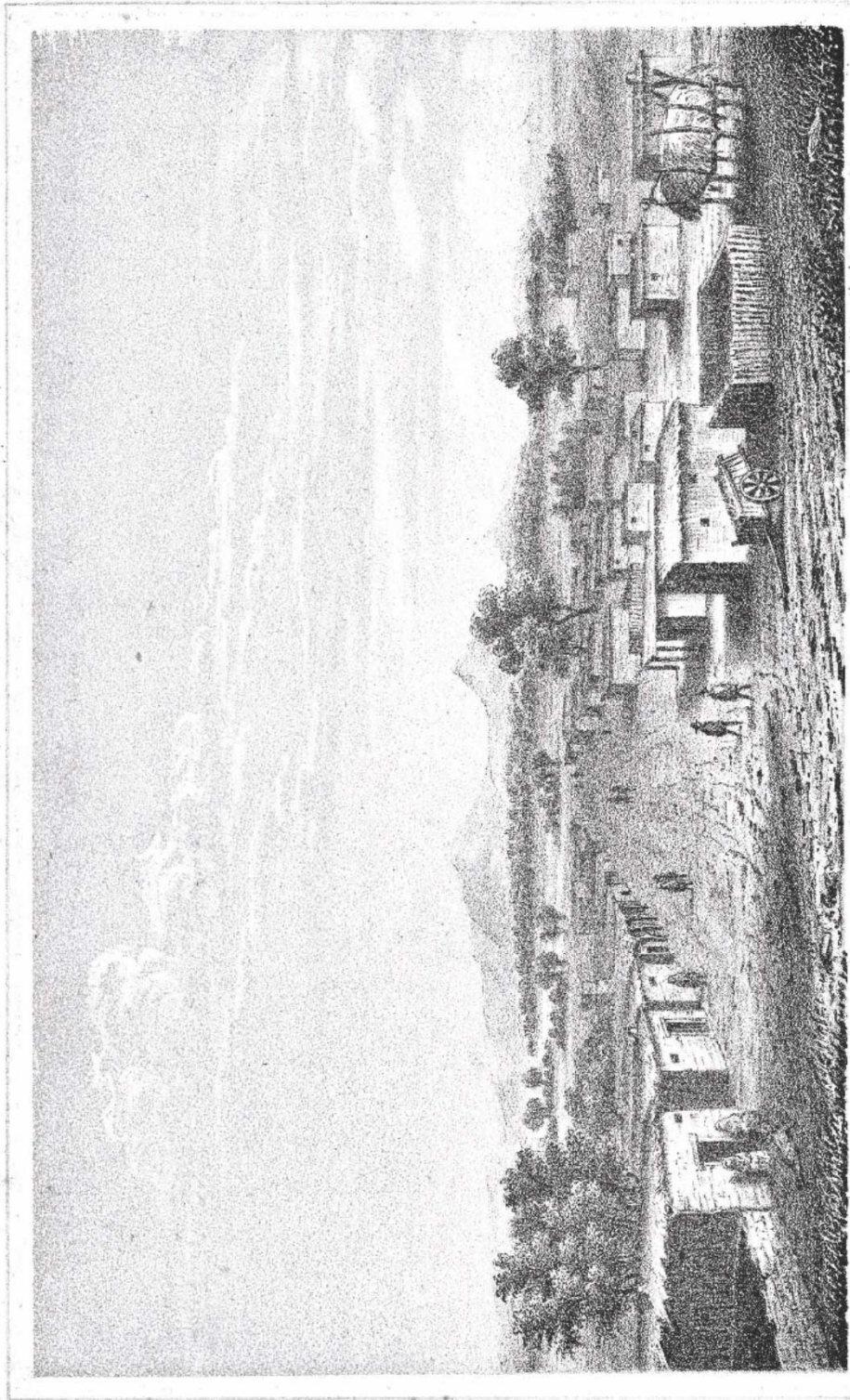

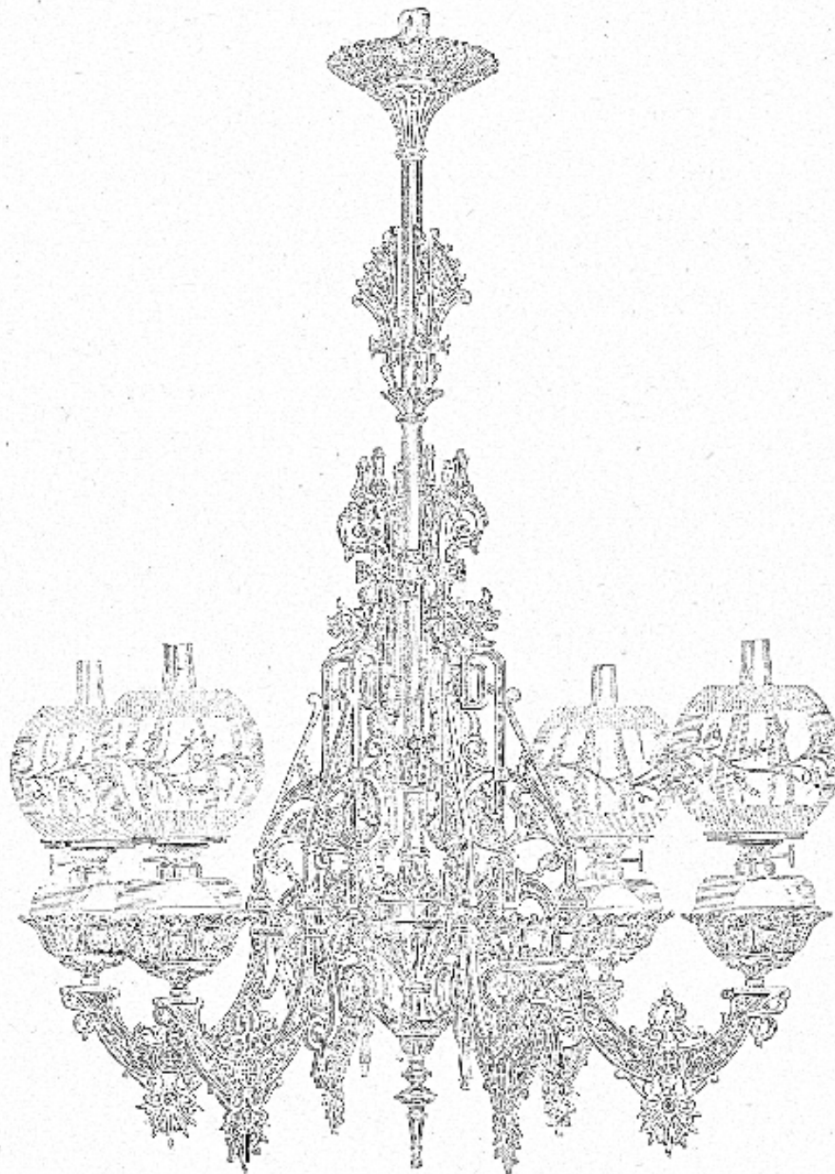

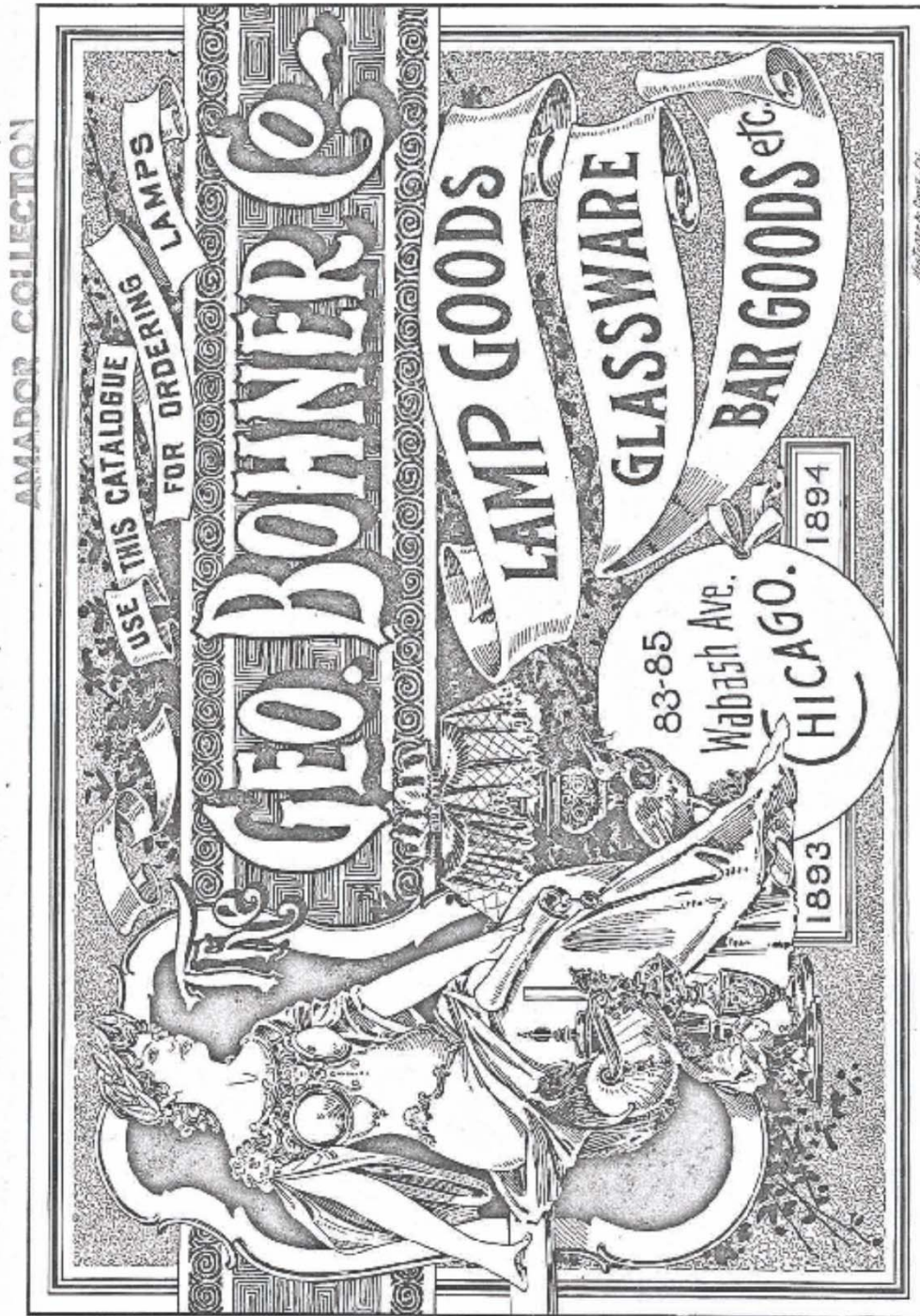
