

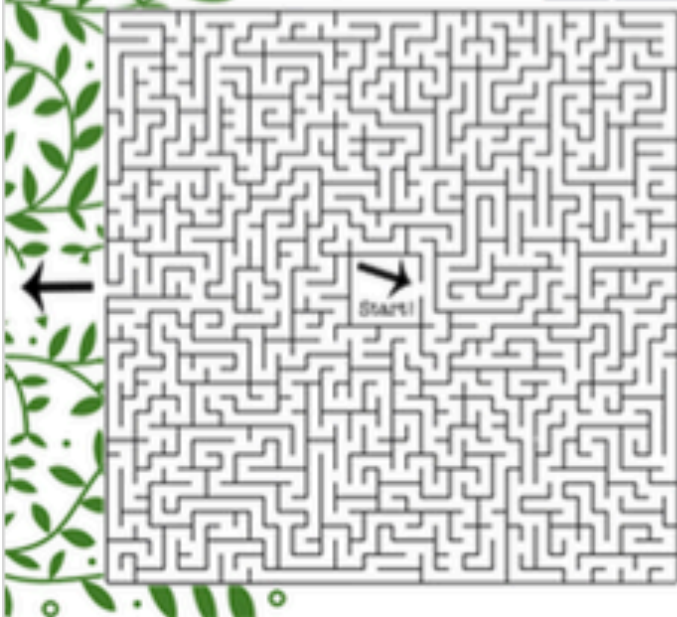
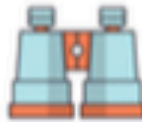
Connect the dots and color in the picture!

- 4) The 1948 manuscript is "Lord of the Pigs."



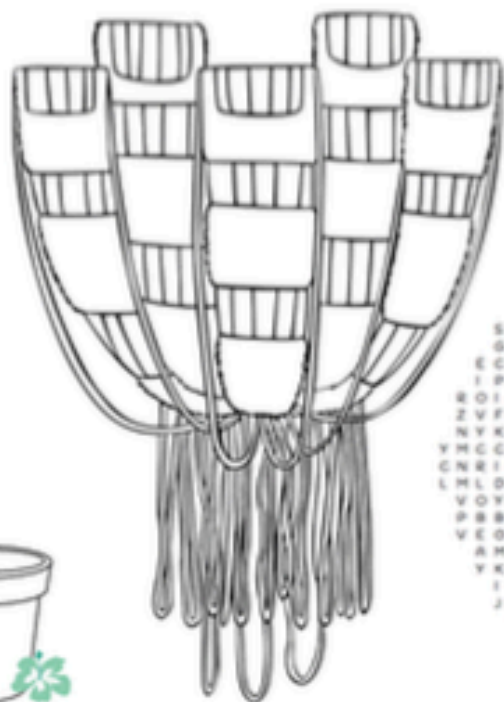
