The William C. Gibson History of Medicine and Science Collection is named in honour of Dr. William Carleton Gibson (1913-2009).

After joining UBC's Faculty of Medicine in 1950, Dr. Gibson served as Professor and Head of the History of Medicine and Science Department. During this time, he spearheaded the construction of UBC's Woodward Biomedical Library and the acquisition of antiquarian books for its Charles Woodward Memorial Room. Strong in early zoology texts, the collection includes Polish naturalist and physician Jan Jonston's richly illustrated seventeenth-century texts on animals.










Monoceros Seu Unicornu aliud Einhorn mit mahnen ein andr art




Ouum galli naturn Regii anno 1628 Aldro




Basiliscus Sius regulus Greuini Aldro


Draco AEthiopicus


Draco bipes apteros captus in Agro Bononienfi


Draco alatus Apes ex Greuino Aldro


*Hydra Septiceps Ges. Aldro


Onager Aldro Wald Efel
