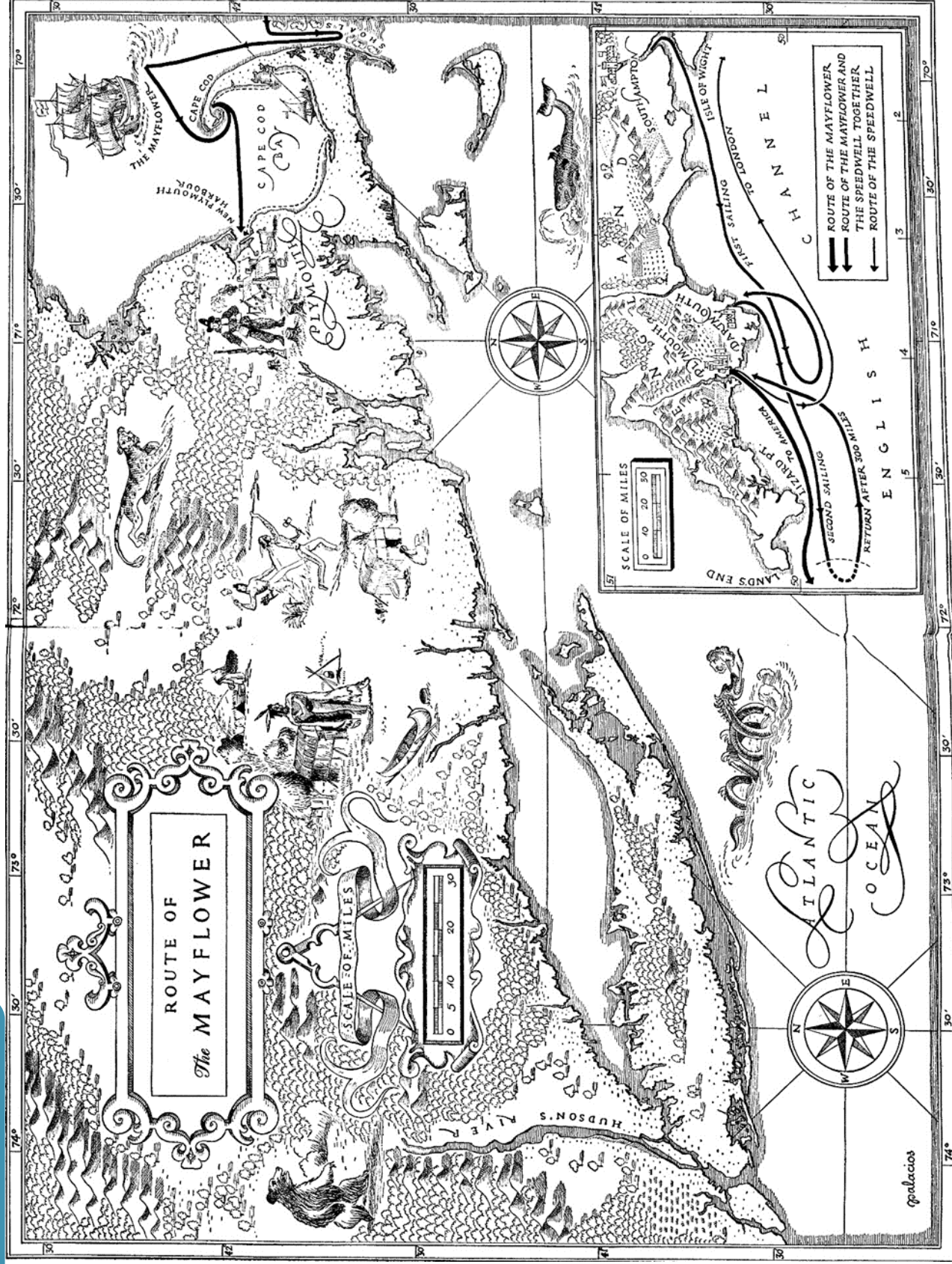

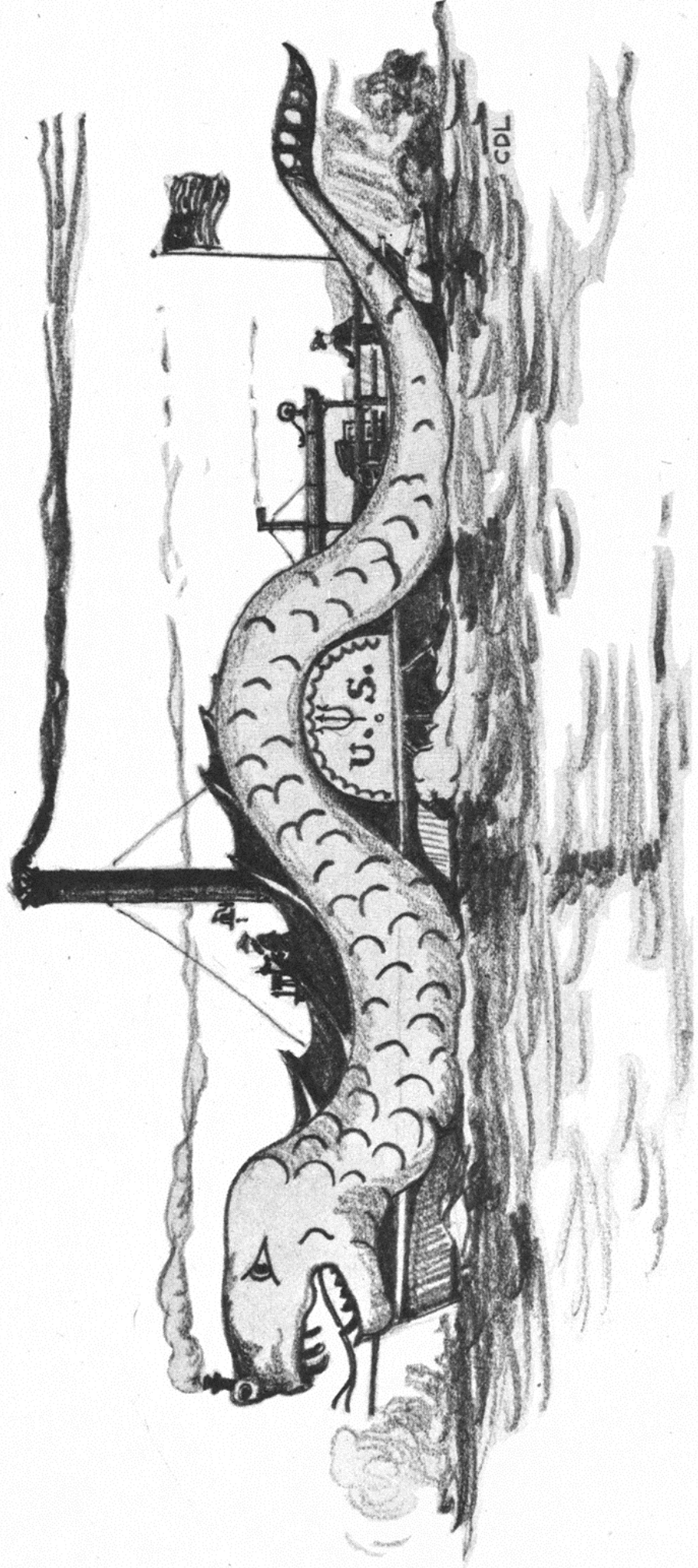

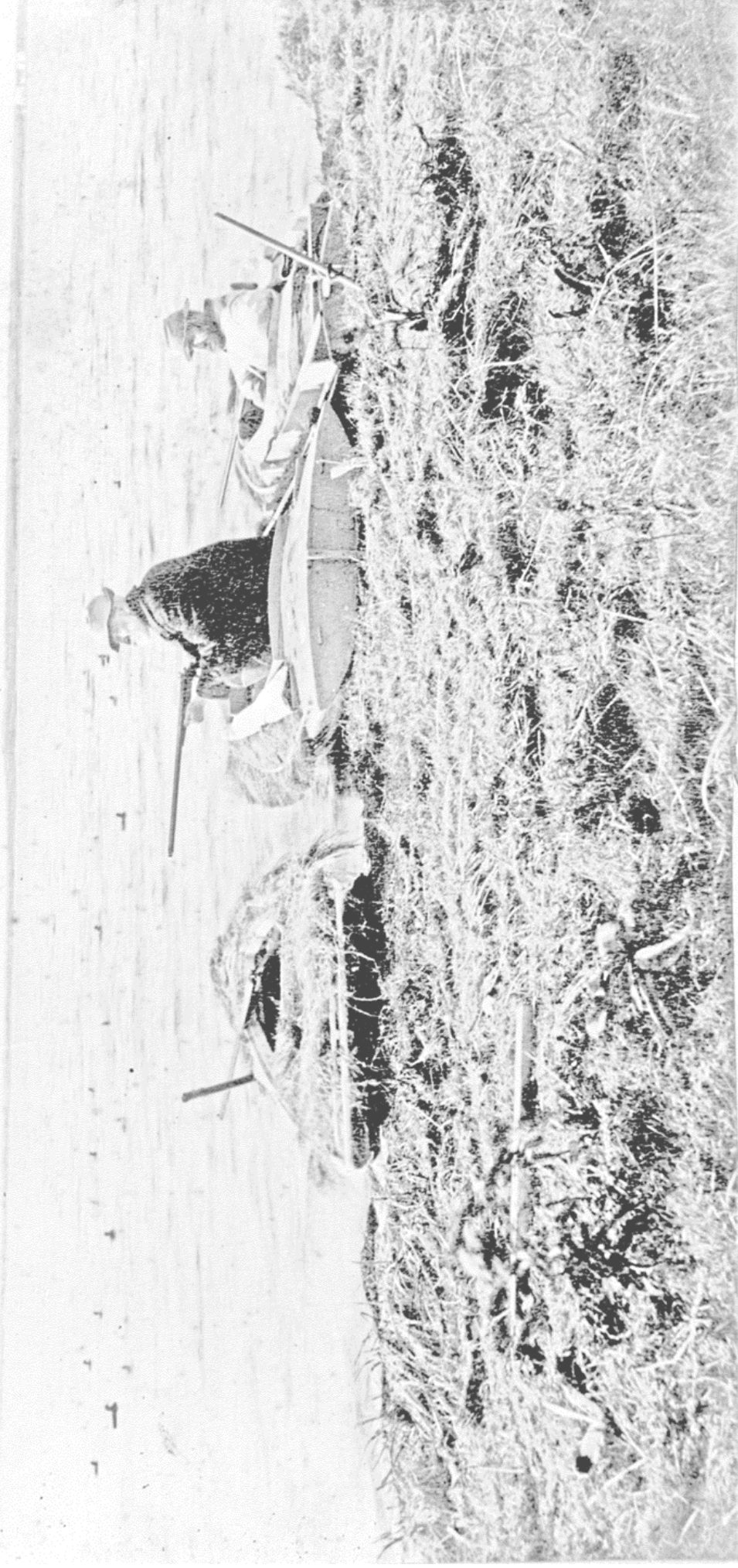


Route of the Mayflower (map). In Gebler, Ernest. *The Plymouth Adventure*. Garden City, New York: Doubleday, 1950.

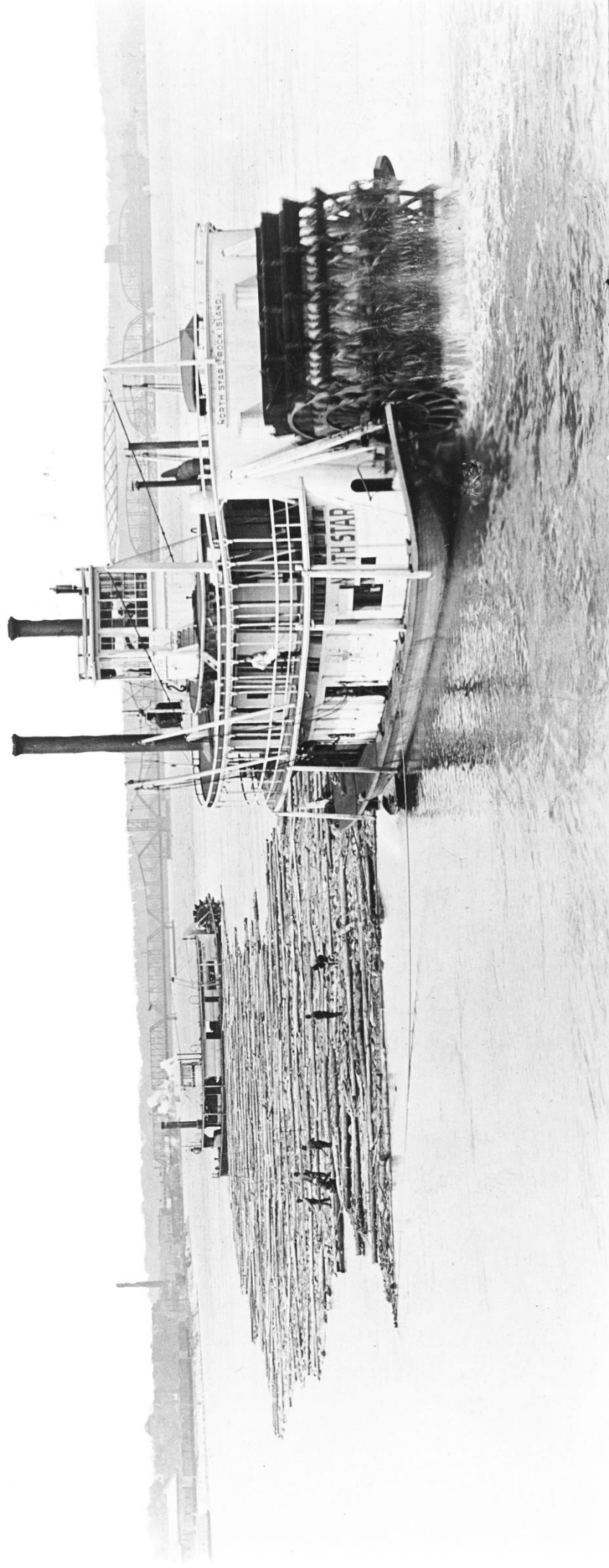


Lane, Carl D. *Western Engineer in American Paddle Steamboats*. New York: Coward-McCann, 1943, 57.

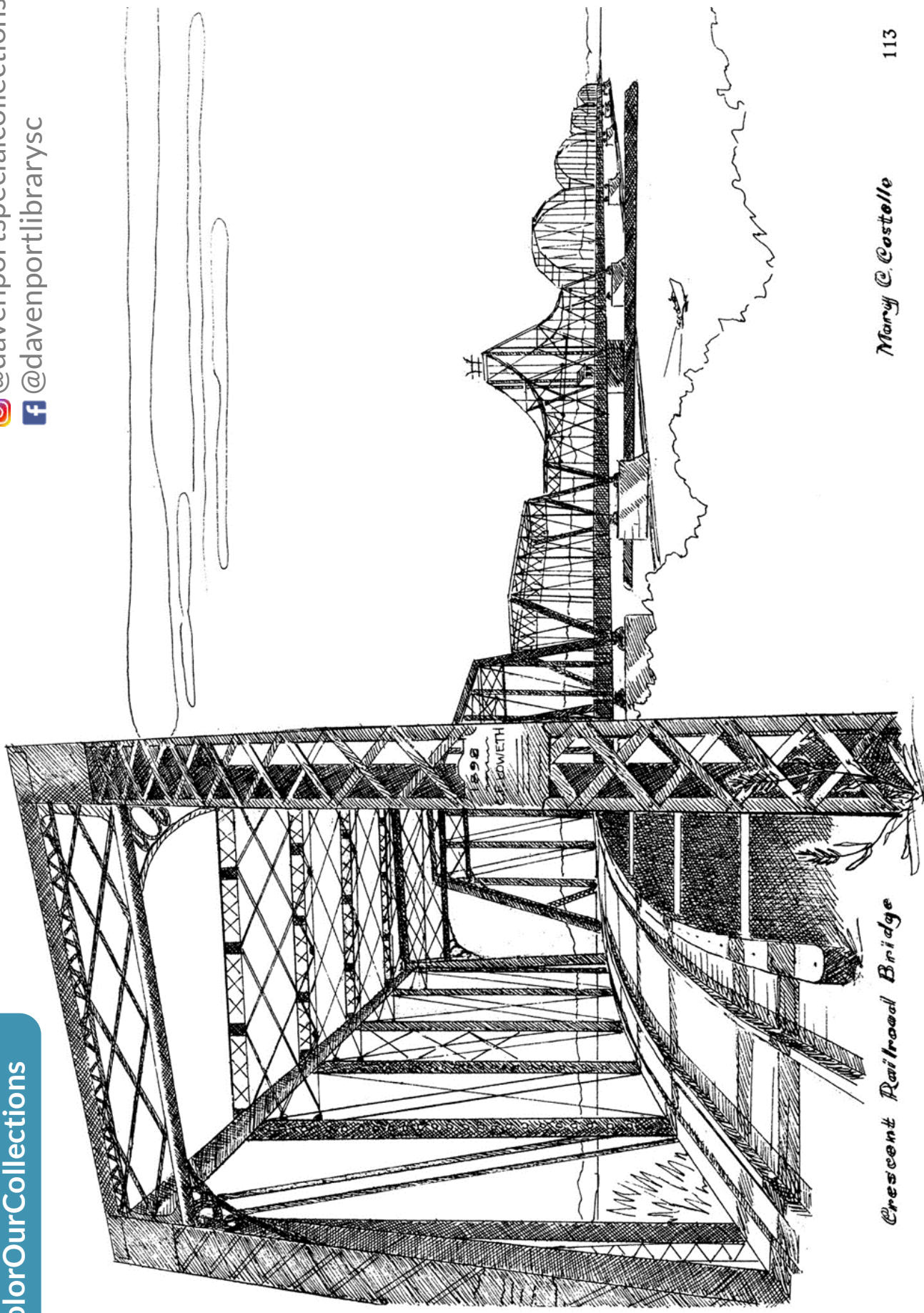
