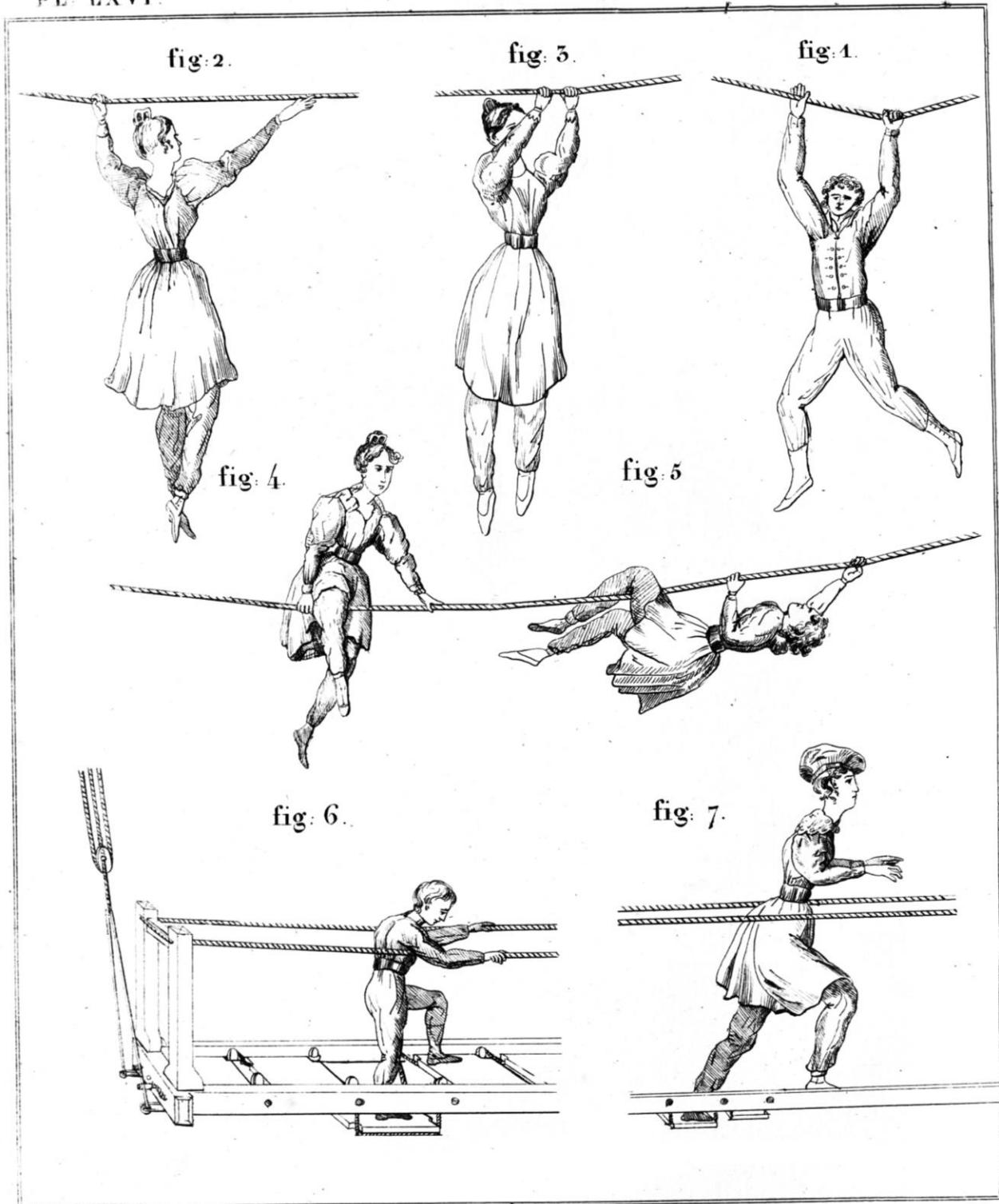


THE LYCEUM BUILDING

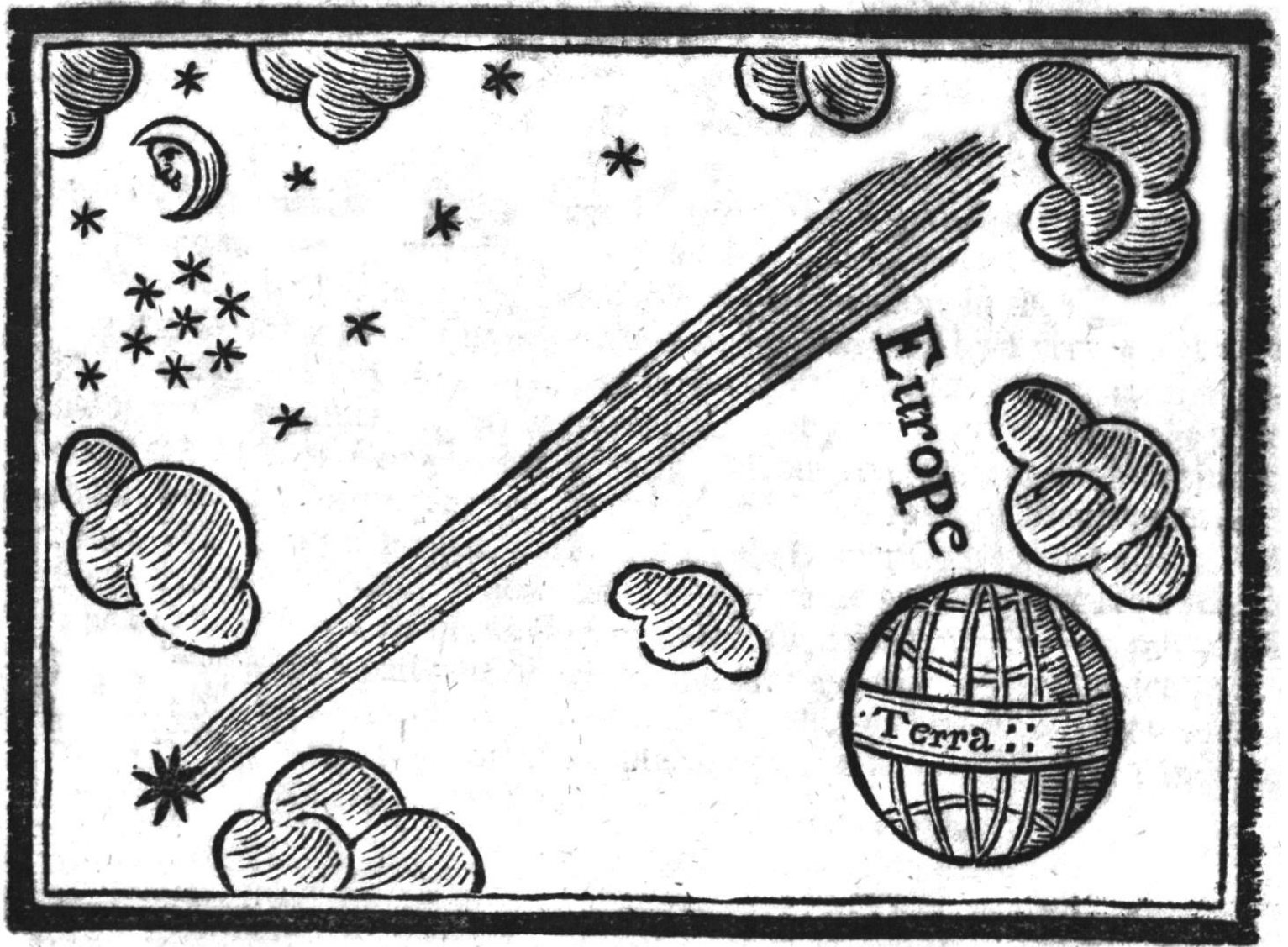

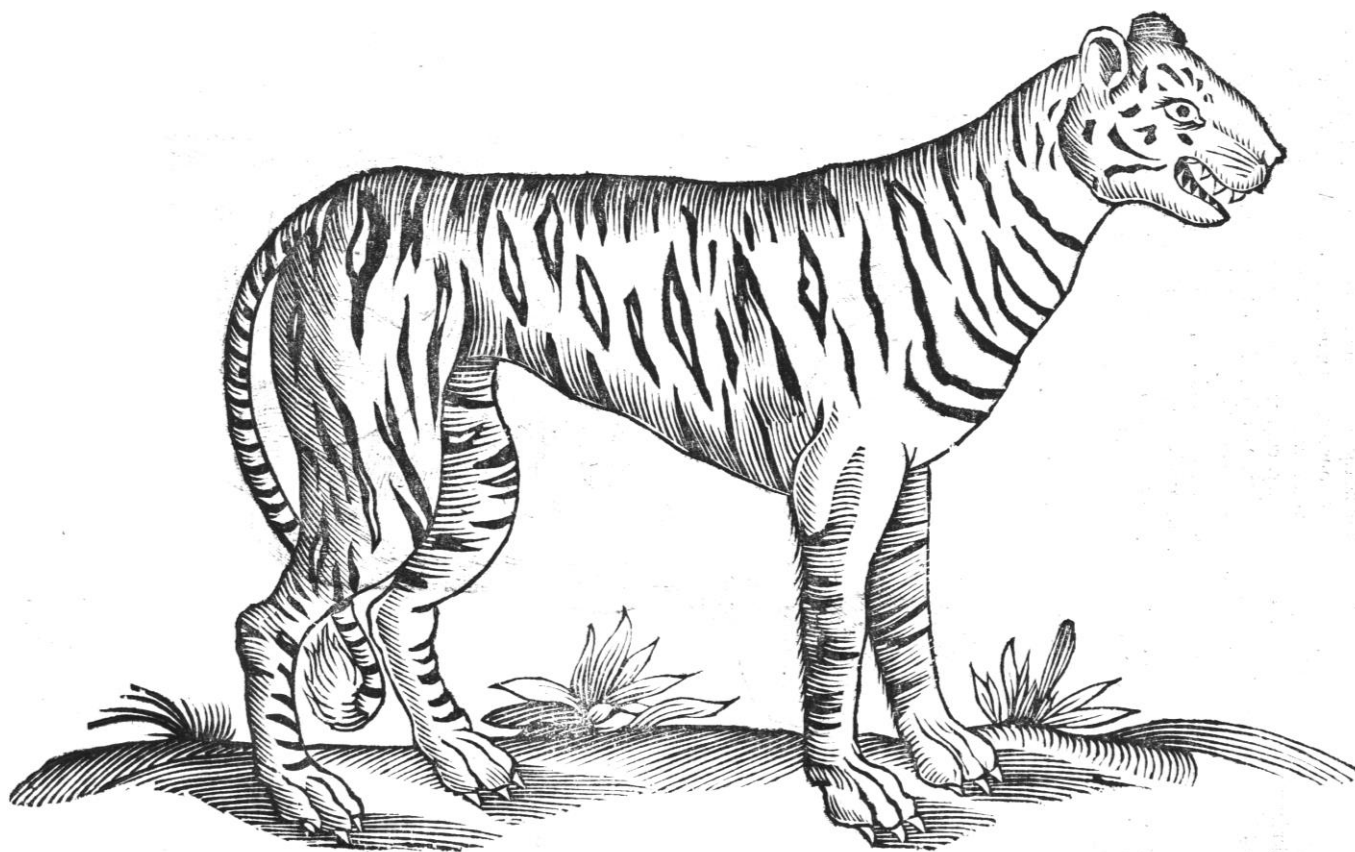
