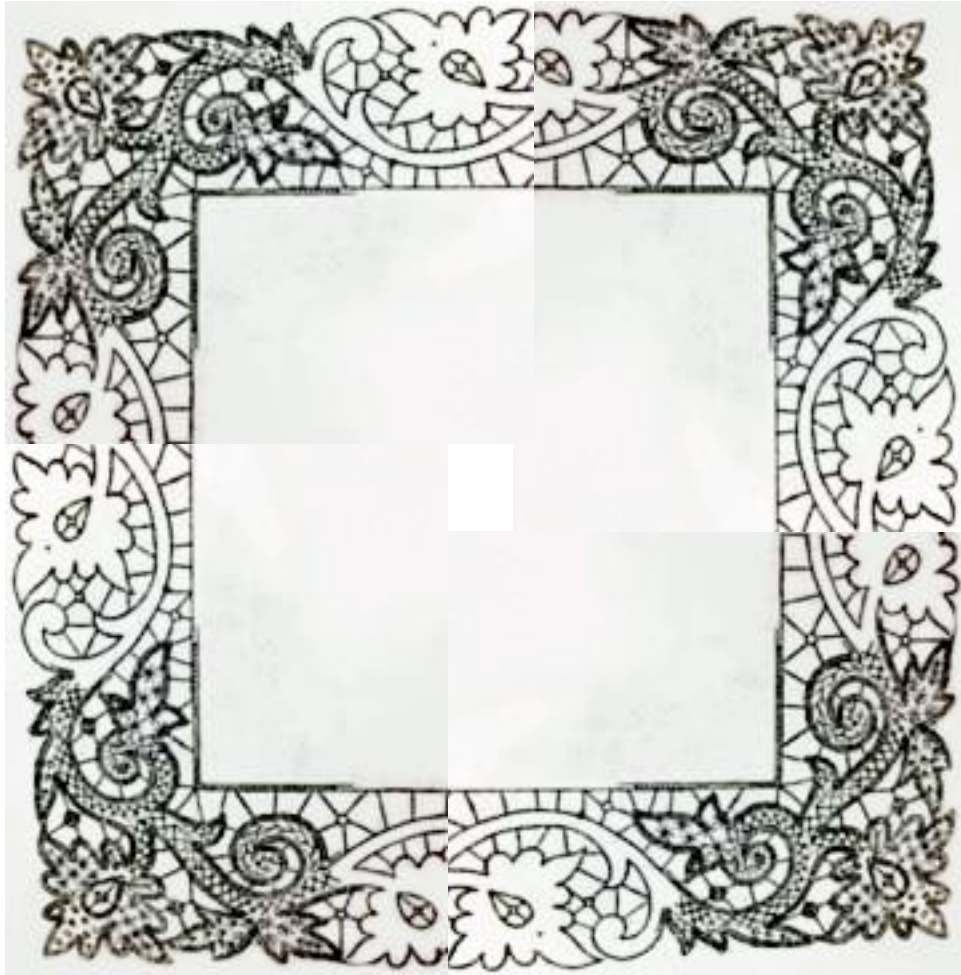

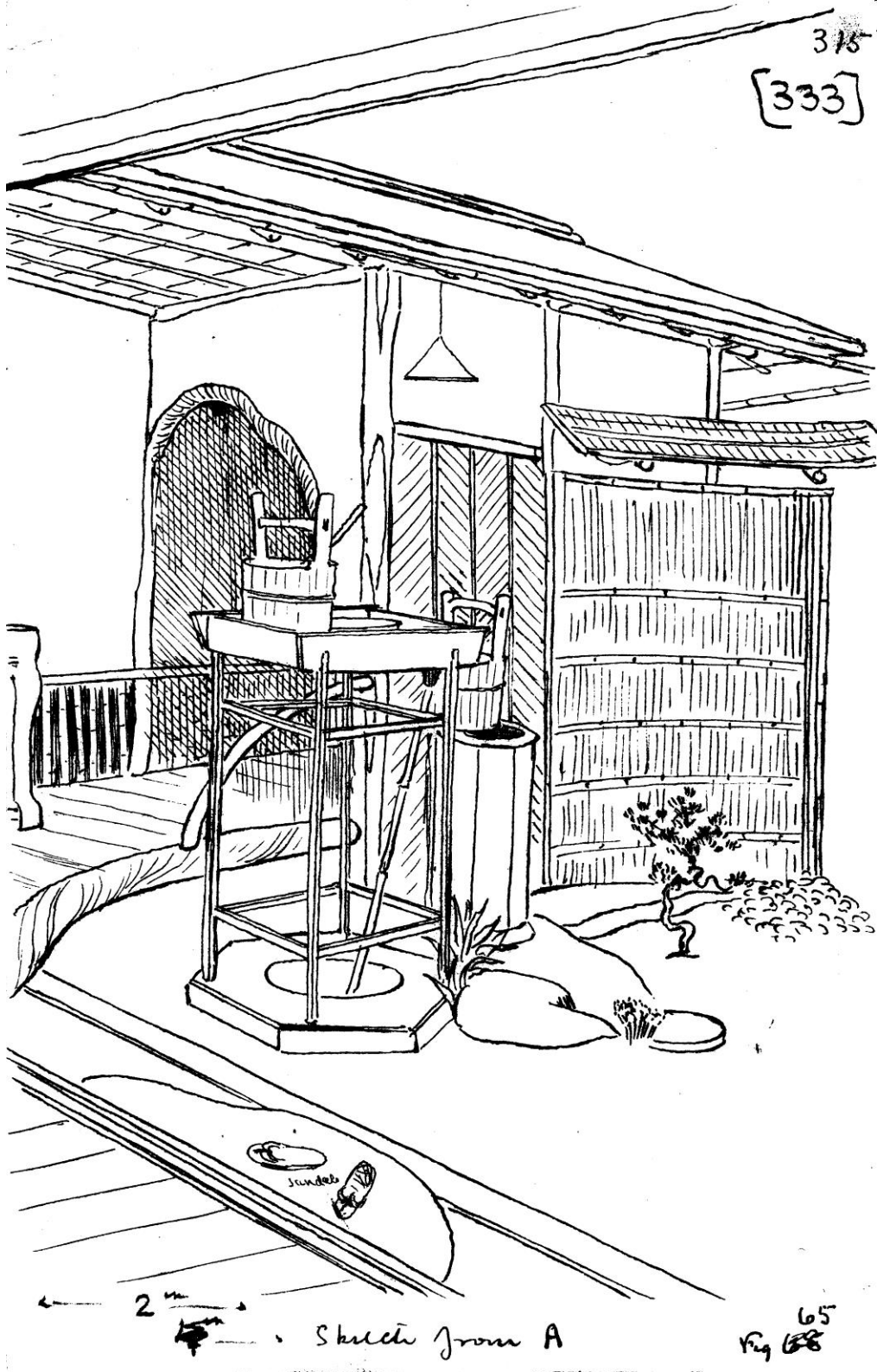

The elders, who usually sat in the high seats, started to use the Bible like a book of rules to strictly control other people in the Meeting, just as the priests had done in England back in 1647. They began to dress and act like the rich people they met in their businesses.

To protest these changes, on February 11, 1822, Jonathan Buffum sat in one of the high seats. Although he had a right to sit here, this made the elders so mad they tried to throw him out. A riot broke out inside the meeting house.
