





François de Sales, Evesque et Prince de Genève, fondateur de l'Ordre de la Visitation, print, Grégoire Huret (MET, 53.600.4216) St. Francis de Sales, the patron saint of writers and journalists, was born in Savoy in 1567 and grew up to become an inspirational preacher; a powerful writer; a friend of the poor; and a saint who, like his model, Saint Francis of Assisi, promoted a simple and devout life. He died in December 1622 and was buried four hundred years ago on January 24, 1623.
