

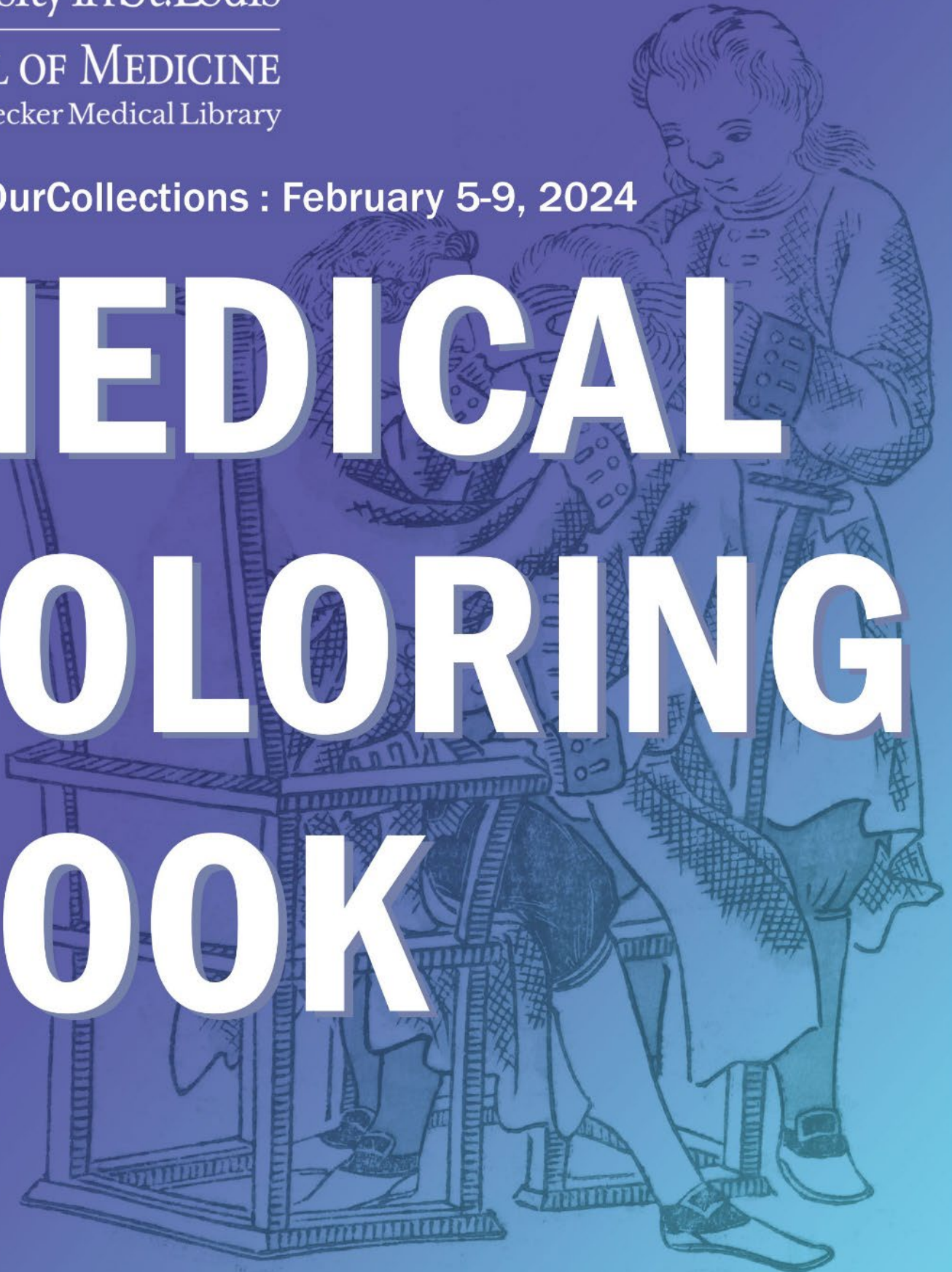

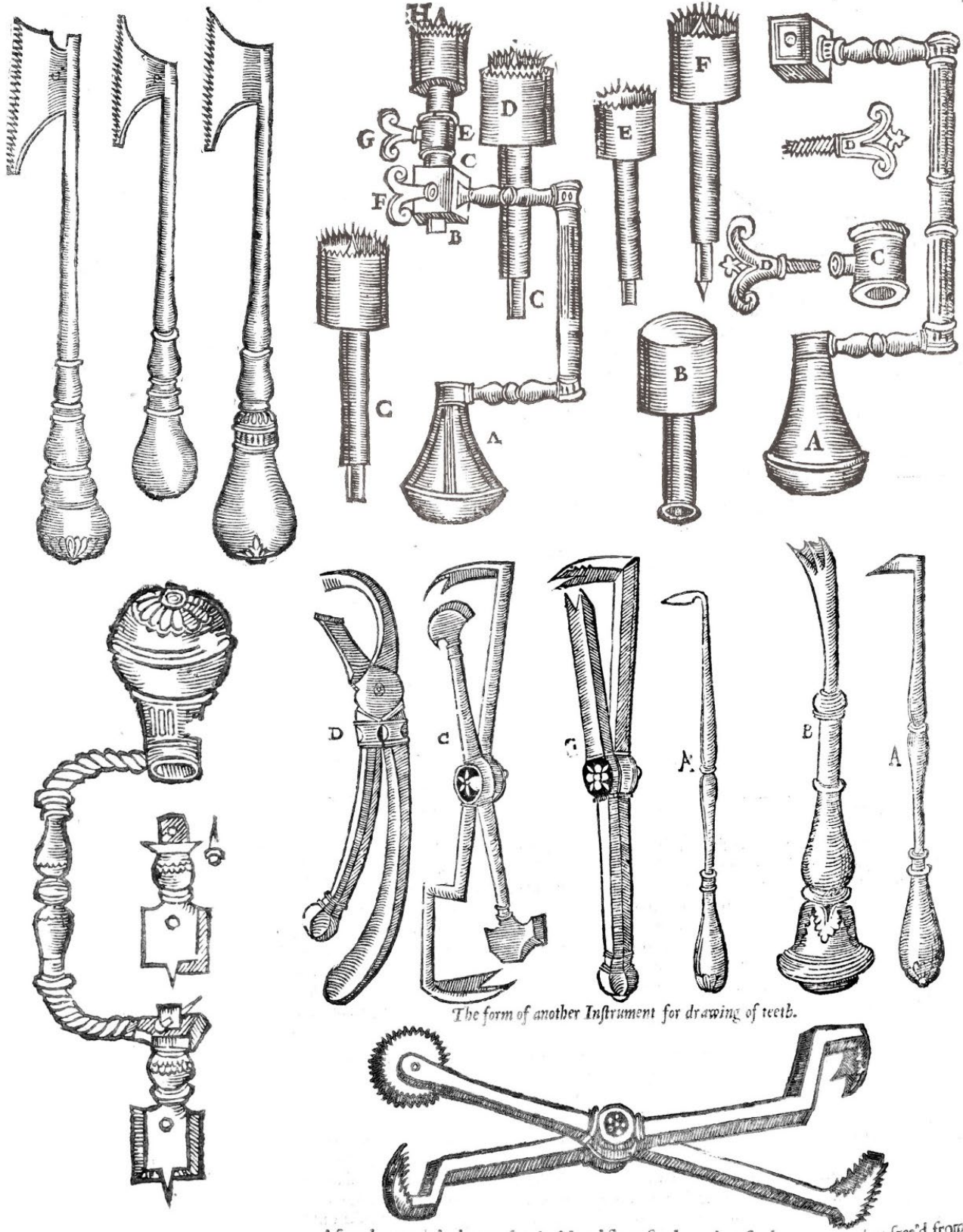
Leonhard Thurneisser zum Thurm. *Quinta Essentia*. Leipzig : bey Hans Steinman, Typis Voegelianis, 1574.

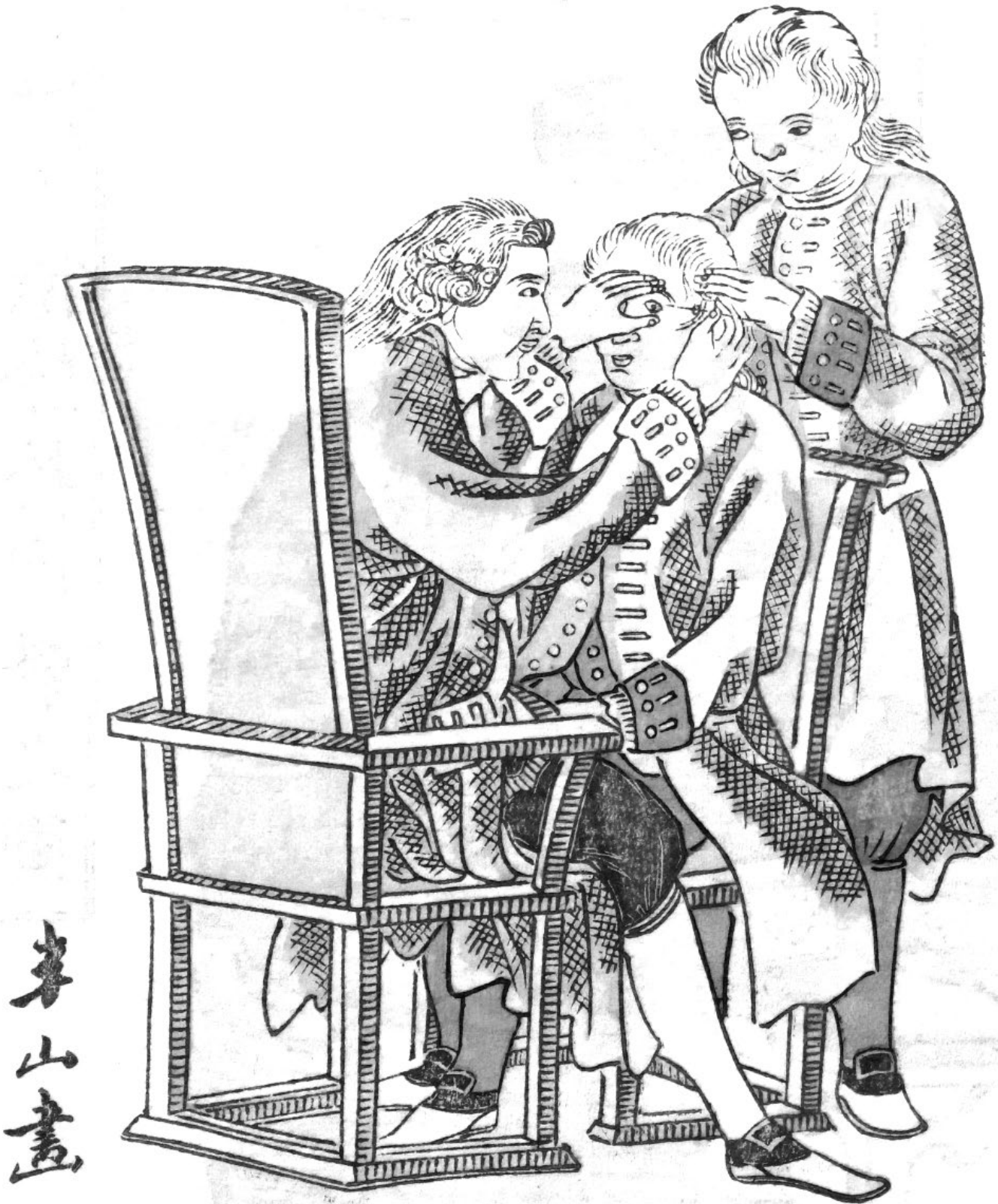

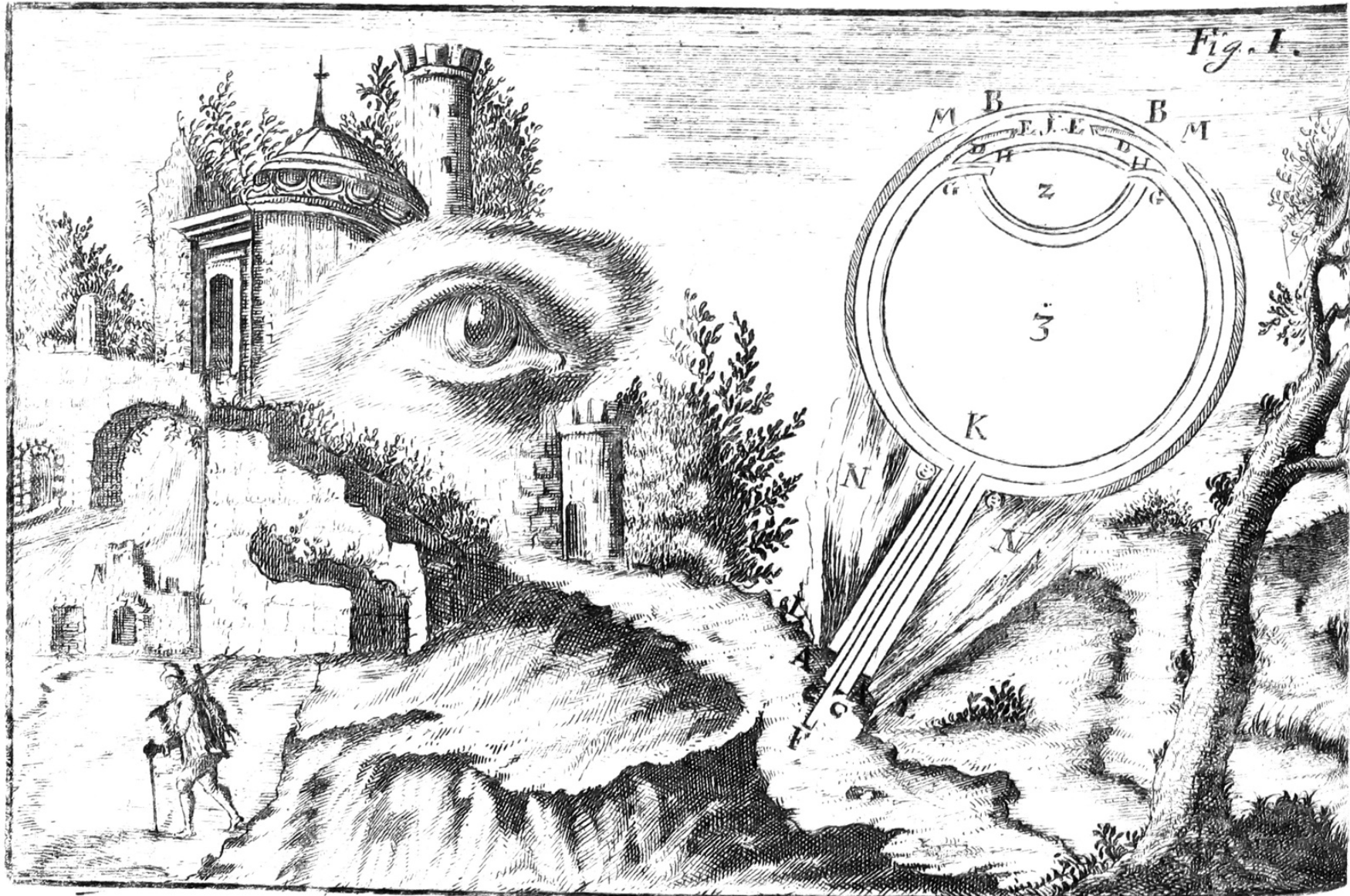

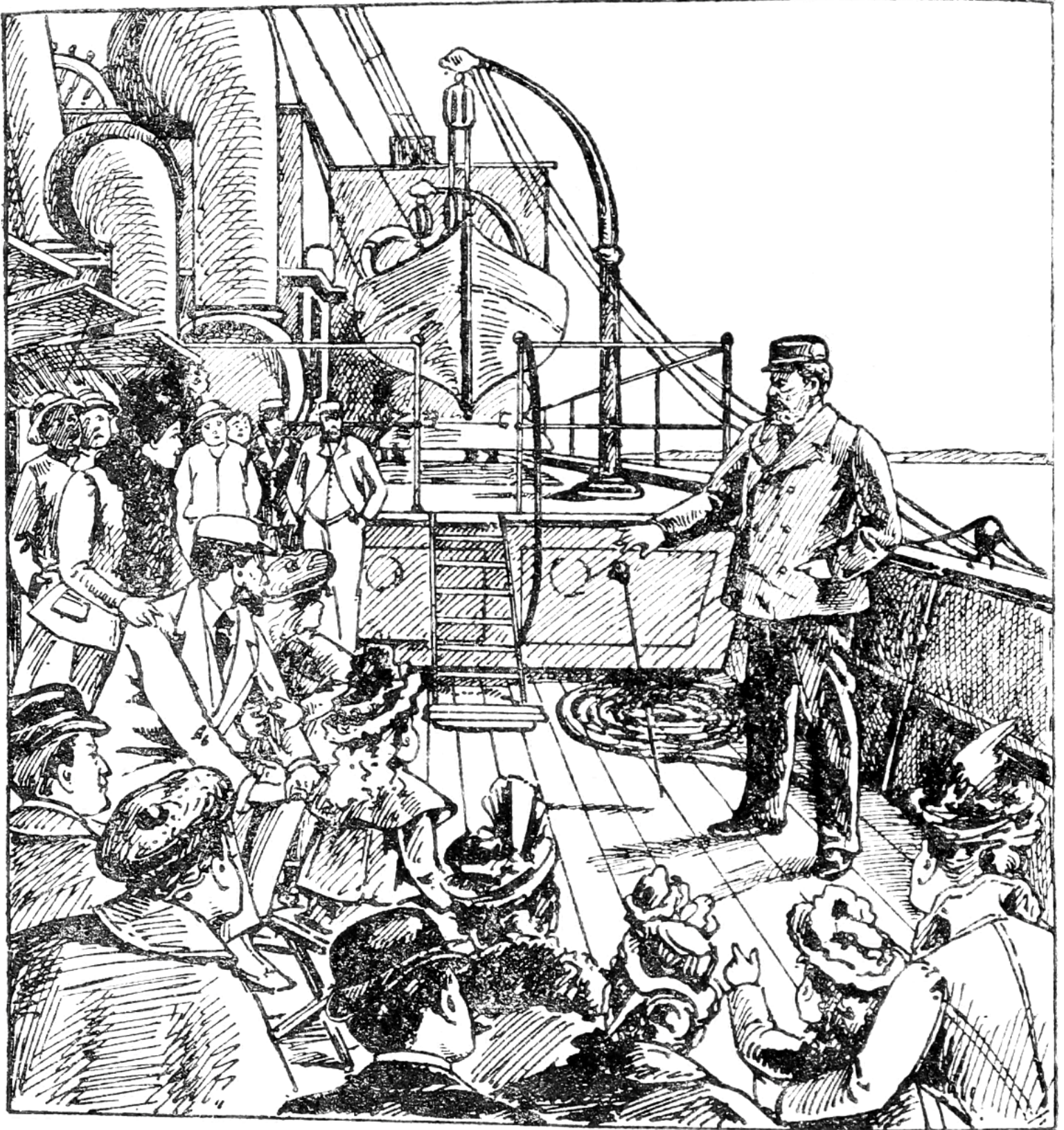

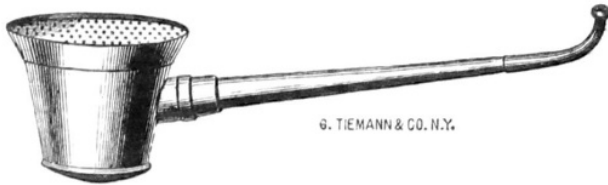


FIG. 2031.—Ear of Dionisius (Paraboloid).

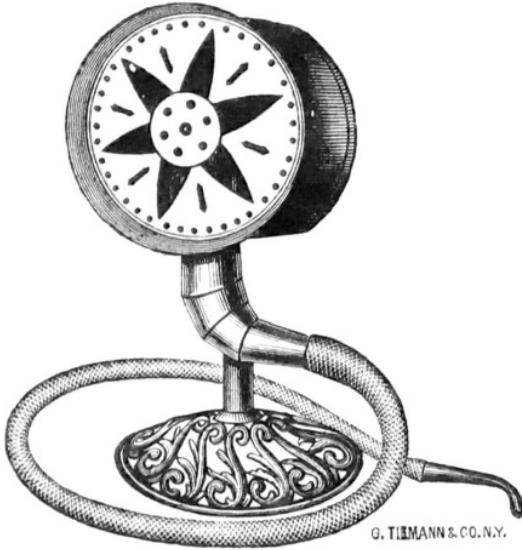


FIG. 2034.—Corrugated Ear Trumpet.



FIG. 2036.—Conversation Tube, to make whispers audible.

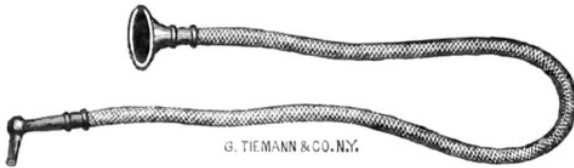


FIG. 2038.—Walking Cane Trumpets.

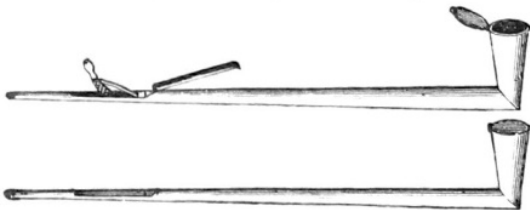


FIG. 2030.—Martineau Hearing Horn.

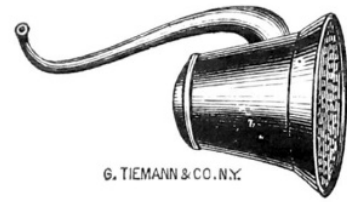


FIG. 2032.

(Paraboloid.)

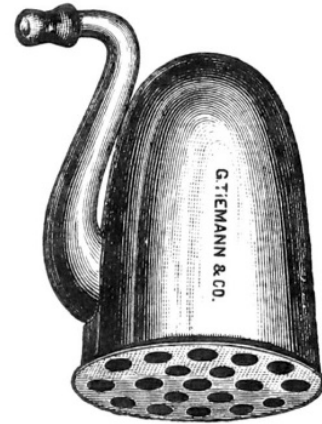


FIG. 2033.—Long Japanned Ear Trumpet.

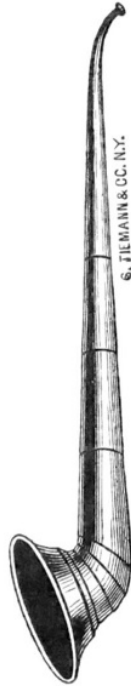


FIG. 2035.—Telescopic Ear Trumpet.

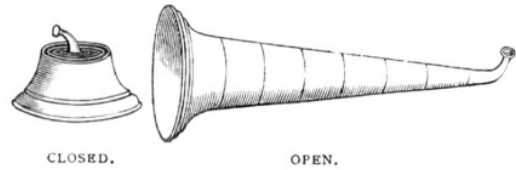


FIG. 2037.—Dome Trumpet.
(Paraboloid.)

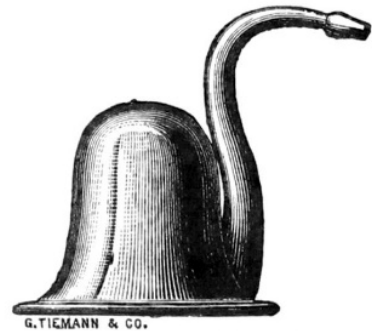


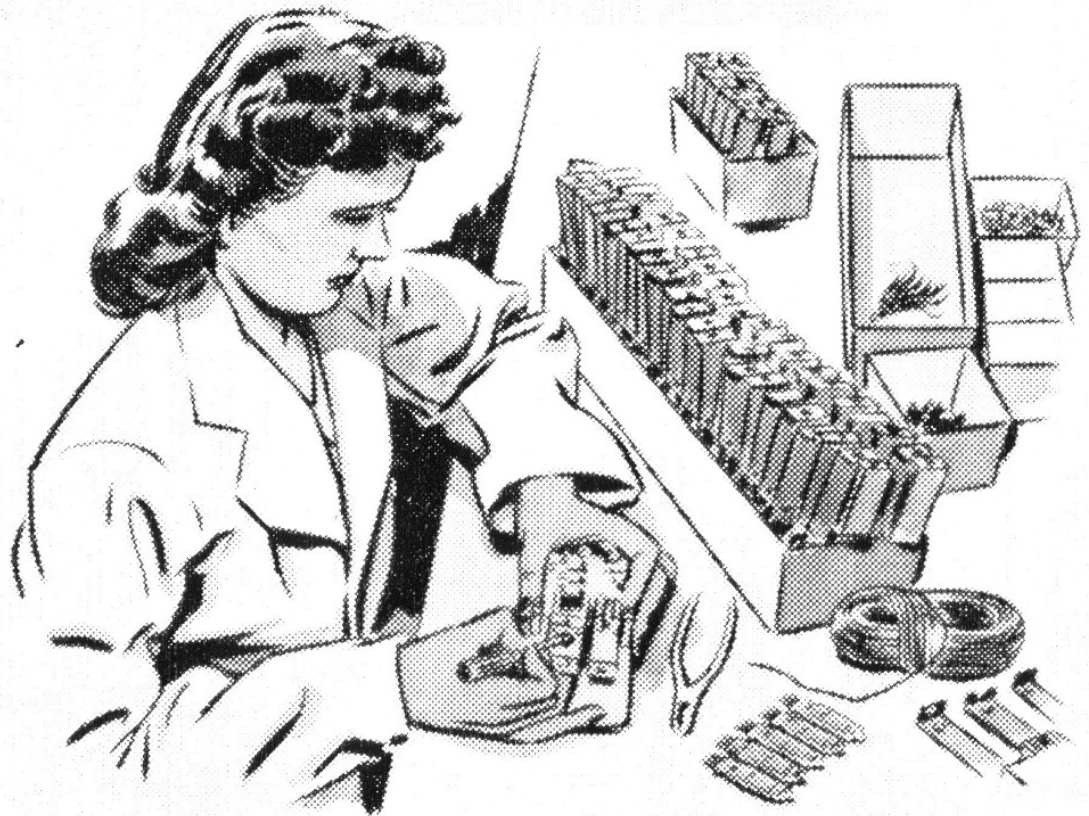
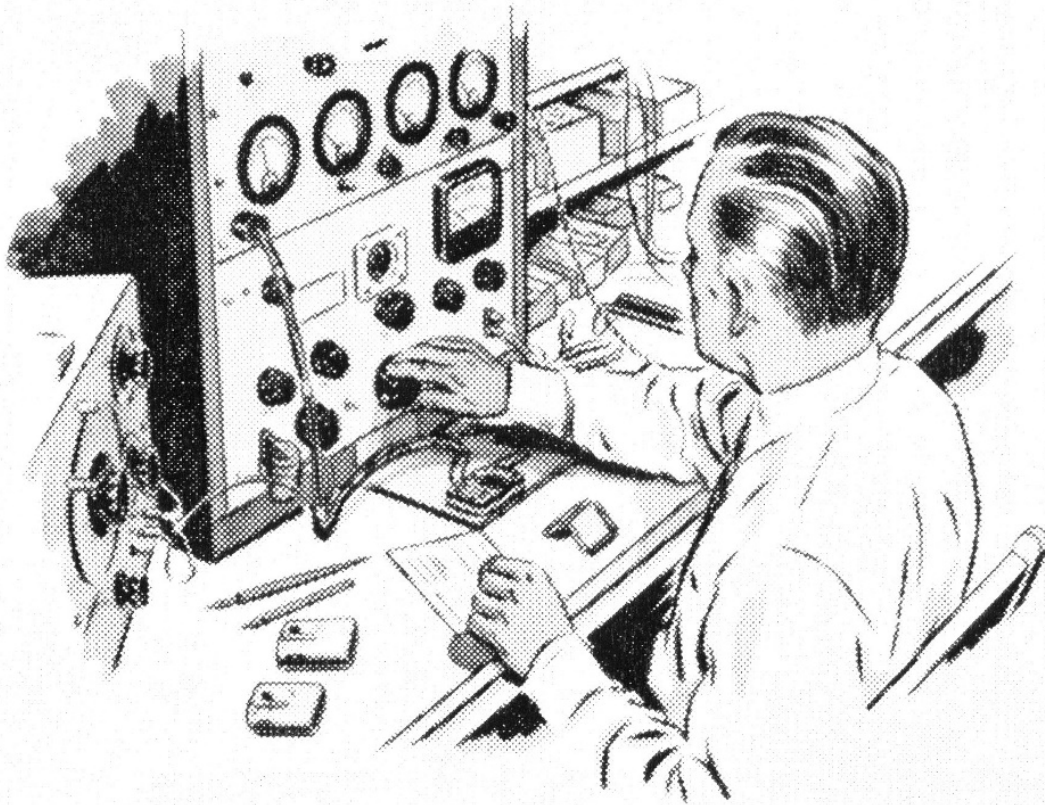
FIG. 2039.—Silver Cornets.
